weather from east Sat Obs 35:29

same and now whales to fair to the  
westward this night carry all sail at  
2 A.M. wore ship to the S.E. latter light  
breeze and fine weather from the eastward  
all hands employed in stowing down

Friday Nov 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. light air  
from the eastward steering by S tacks  
with all sail set all hands employed  
in stowing down at 5 finished at 7  
took in main top G sail and fly  
Jib one sail in sight hoisting  
at 9 A.M. spoke the Ann Mary ann of Sag  
Sag Harbour Capt. Winfers 3200 bls  
of oil at 11 saw him take a dead whale  
long side latter light breeze and fine  
weather Sat Obs 35:33 Song by Chron 167:20

Saturday November 6<sup>th</sup> 1847  
P.M. light breeze and fine  
weather from the eastward steering by S tacks  
with all sail set the two last mentioned sails  
in sight at 6 tack ship to the S.E.  
at 1 A.M. tacked to the north at 8 tacked to S.E.  
latter light breeze and fine weather from E & S.E.  
Sat Obs 35:12

Sunday Nov 7<sup>th</sup> P.M. light breeze  
and fine weather from E & S.E. steering  
by S tacks at 7 double reefed the top  
sails at 5 A.M. set all sail and kept E & S.E.  
latter brisk breeze and fine weather from N & N.W.  
Sat Obs 36:03  
Song by Chron 167:58

Monday Nov 8<sup>th</sup> P.M. the weather the  
same steering E & S.E. with all sail set at 7  
double reefed the top sails and hoisted to the  
S.E. at 2 A.M. wore ship to the westward at 8  
kept of S.E. fresh gale and cloudy from  
N & N.W.  
Sat Obs 36:51

Tuesday Nov 9<sup>th</sup> P.M. hoisted to the  
wind to S.E. at 3 saw a sail standing  
to S eastward fresh gale and cloudy from  
N & N.W. at 4 took in sail to double reef  
top sails at 10 A.M. kept away E & S.E. latter  
fresh gale and cloudy Sat Obs 36:14
