S.W. latter part more moderate set
double reefed top sails Sat Obs 36:09 P

Thursday Nov 18th P.M. spoke the
Ship Grover New London Capt. J. J. J.
27 ments out 3500 lbs of oil 500 of it
sperm at 2 set fore and main sail
fresh breeze and a heavy swell on from
the S. westward repaired the mizzen
top sail at 5 A.M. set all sail and wore
ship to the south latter light breeze from
the westward saw the Dover kept of S.E.
Sat Obs 35:28

Friday Nov 19th P.M. light breeze from
the westward steering by stacks with all
sail set at 5 saw 2 whale gyrene quick
to E.S.E. at 7 double reefed the top sails
at 5 A.M. set all sail at 11 kept of S.E.
latter light breeze from S.W.
Sat Obs 36:29 P
Long by Chron 162:46 W

Saturday Nov 20th P.M. kept E.S.E.
at 7 took in fore and mizzen top
sails and luffed to the wind to S.W. light
breeze and cloudy at 5 A.M. set all
sail and kept of S.E. latter light
breeze and lousy from S.W.
Sat. est 37:15
Long do 162:00 W

Sunday November 21st 1847
P.M. light breeze and lousy
from S.W. steering S.E. with all sail set
at 7 took in fore and mizzen top sails at 5 A
set whole top sails latter fresh breeze and thick and
rainy from the north Sat. est 38:00
Long do 160:50 W

Monday Nov 22nd P.M. the breeze came
to the east steered by stacks aboard at 7 took
in fore and mizzen top sails fresh gale and
thick rainy weather from E at 8 A.M. comes
on heavy gale took in fore sail and close reefed
the main top sail latter heavy gale and rain
Sat. est 38:30
Long do 164:10

Tuesday Nov 23rd P.M. the gale came to
the S.E. at 5 wore ship to the eastward
lying under close reef main top sail and stay
sails latter part more moderate set double
reefed top sails Sat Obs 38:38
Long by Chron 161:29

Wednesday Nov 24th P.M. light breeze
and a heavy swell on from S.E. sent down
the fore and commence repairing it one
sail in sight of the lee quarter middle
part light air from the eastward latter
nearly calm Sat Obs 37:51 P
Long by Chron 161:40

Thursday Nov 25th P.M. light air from
the westward kept S.E. at 7 double reefed
the top sails the above mention sail in
sight standing S.E. middle and latter
light breeze and fine weather Sat 38:32
Long by Chron 160:33
