 fresh gale and hazy at 7 took in sail  
 and luffed to the north at 8 A.M. wore  
 ship to the S.E. latter fresh gale and heavy  
 swell on Sat. obs 40:16

Sunday Nov 28<sup>th</sup> P.M. more moderate  
 set. whole main top sail at 7 double reefed  
 it light breeze from S.W. middle the  
 wind came to the S.W. at 5 set all sail  
 at 7 kept of S.W. latter brisk breeze and hazy  
 Sat. obs 40:32

Monday Nov 29<sup>th</sup> P.M. brisk breeze and  
 fine weather from S.W. kept S.P.W. at 7  
 took in fore and mizzen top sails and luffed  
 to the westward fresh gale and cloudy latter  
 part fresh gale and rain from S. latest 41:21  
 Song do 160:10 W

Tuesday Nov 30<sup>th</sup> P.M. 5 the wind came  
 to S.W. and comes on heavy gale took in  
 fore sail and close reefed the main top  
 sail lying S. tacks aboard at 5 set jib  
 and main sail latter part fresh gale and  
 heavy swell on Sat. obs 41:48  
 Song by Chron 159:34  
 Song by lunar 159:58 W

Wednesday December 1<sup>st</sup> 1847  
 P.M. fresh gale and heavy swell on  
 from S.W. steering by S. tacks under double reef  
 top sails and courses at 7 took in jib and main  
 sail one sail in sight standing S.E. at daylight  
 set all sail and kept away S.E. at 9 raised R. whale  
 lowered and chased without success the above mention  
 sail in sight had bin chasing the same whale  
 at 10 wore kept of E.P.C. and the other ship  
 kept S.E. Sat. est. 42:35  
 Song est 158:20 W

Thursday Dec 2<sup>nd</sup> P.M. fresh breeze and heavy  
 from the north kept E.P.C. at 6 took in  
 fore and mizzen top sails fresh gale and thick  
 and rain saw R. whale off the beam  
 middle the wind light and hailing and rain at 8  
 came to the south and come on fresh gale at 8  
 took in fore sail and close reef the main top sail  
 Sat. obs 42:57  
 Song by Chron 168:30

Friday Dec 3<sup>rd</sup> P.M. heavy gale from  
 S.W. lying under close reef main top sails  
 and stay sails S. tacks middle and latter part  
 more moderate set double reef top sails at 8 wore  
 ship to the eastward Sat. obs 42:58  
 Song by Chron 168:20

Saturday Dec 4<sup>th</sup> P.M. fresh breeze and a  
 heavy swell on from the south steering by with  
 S. tacks aboard under double reef top sails  
 at 11 wore ship to the south at 9 raised R. whale  
 struck him and sunk him latter calm and  
 fine weather one sail in sight Sat. obs 42:50
