sea on from S.W. steering by stacks

and mizzen top sails at 7 more ship to  
S.W. fresh gale and heavy from the westward  
latter part fresh gale a Bark in

Sunday December 19<sup>th</sup> 1847

P.M. the gale continues  
the same lying under double reef main top  
sail and fore sail the last mention  
Bark in sight astern at 12 more ship  
to the south at 9 spoke the Ship Abrown Bark  
Braiton Ryed fore 2800 lbs latter blowing  
fresh gale lying under double reef main top sail  
Sat obs 45:15

Monday Dec 20<sup>th</sup> P.M. the weather continues  
the same lying to heading to the south  
latter the gale increases frequent squalls of rain  
and hock Sat obs 45:31  
Song est 150:50

Tuesday Dec 21<sup>st</sup> P.M. the gale continues  
the same at 4 close reefed the main top sail  
and more ship to the westward the wind  
came to S.W. latter the same Sat obs 45:08  
Song by Chron 151:02

Wednesday Dec 22<sup>nd</sup> P.M. the weather  
the same lying under close reef main  
top sail and fore sail heading to the  
westward at daylight set double reef top sails  
Sib and main sail and more ship to the south  
Sat obs 44:55  
Song est 151:20 W

Thursday Dec 23<sup>rd</sup> P.M. fresh breeze  
from the westward steering by stacks aboard  
under double reef top sails Sib and main  
sail at 8 took in Sib and main sail at 10  
comes on heavy gale took in fore and mizzen top  
sails latter the weather the same one sail in  
sight of the weather quarter Sat obs 45:44
