at 1 P.M. were
Ship to the westward at 6 took in fore and
mizzen top sails and close reefed the main fresh
gale and lowry from N.W. middle beam
gale and rain took in the fore sail at 8 A.M.
the wind came to the westward and cleared
of fine weather set double reefed top sails
and wore Ship to the north latter light
breeze and a heavy swell on one sail in sight
Sat obs 47:41 P

Sunday Jan 2nd P.M. were Ship to
the westward light breeze from N.W.
at 4 raised R. whales lowered and chased
them but without success the above
mention sail to the windward chasing
whales middle rain latter part fine weather
employed in chasing R. whales and stowing
down in the after hold saw the above mention
sail take whale one other sail in sight
Sat obs 47:38

Monday Jan 3rd P.M. all hands employed
in stowing down at 8 finished at 8.30 double
reefed the top sails thick and lowry from
the north at 8 A.M. fine weather lowered
twice for R. whales but without success
saw a Ship sink one to the windward caught
the Gargua one other sail in sight to the
ward latter fresh breeze and fine weather
Sat obs 47:36

Tuesday January 4th 1848

P.M. fresh gale from
N.W. at 4 lowered for R. whales but the
same old story at 8 double reefed the top sails
one sail in sight cutting in a whale middle part
fresh gale and rain at 10 wore Ship to the
westward at 8 A.M. set whole top sails and
wore to N. eastward latter fresh breeze and lowry
Sat obs 47:36
Song est 151:04 W

Wednesday Jan 5th P.M. moderate breeze
and cloudy from the north seeing by 8
tacks aboard at 8 double reefed the top sails
two sails in sight one to the windward and
the other to the leeward saw sun pinbacks
latter part calm and foggy two sails in sight
a boiling
Sat est 47:40
Song est 150:40

Thursday Jan 6th P.M. the fog lifted up
and took light breeze from the north raised
R. whales lowered and chased but the same
old story at 8 double reefed the top sails
three sails in sight to of them a boiling
at 2 A.M. wore Ship to N.E. at 4 set all sail
8 wore to the westward latter fresh breeze from
N.W.

Friday Jan 7th P.M. fresh breeze and lowry
from the north at 8 wore Ship to the
eastward at 8 double reefed the top sails
latter part calm and lowry nothing in sight
Sat est 47:50
