 S.W. steering by S. tacks aboard at 8 took
 in fore and mizzen top sails middle and
 latter fresh gale and lowry from S.W. Sat est 47:50

Monday Jan 10th 8 AM fresh gale and lowry
 from S.W. took in fore and mizzen top
 sails heading to S.E. middle and latter part
 the weather much the same Sat obs 47:57

Tuesday Jan 11th 8 AM the wind came more
 to the westward and blowing fresh gale flying
 under double reef main top sail and fore
 sail heading to the north at 9 kept S.E.
 and set fore top sail latter fresh gale from
 S.W. Sat obs 47:50

Wednesday Jan 12th 8 AM the weather continues
 the same steering E double reef top sails
 set middle and latter parts more moderate
 set whole top sails and main top sail
 Sat obs 48:00 W

Thursday January 13th 1848
 8 AM kept S.E. by E
 fresh gale from W.S.W. at 9 kept S.E. middle
 and latter part more moderate Sat obs 46:58

Friday Jan 14th 8 AM brisk breeze from
 S.W. and flying clouds steering S.E. with all
 sail set middle part nearly calm latter brisk
 breeze from the south steering S.W. with all sail
 set Sat obs 46:35
 Song by Chron 138:15

Saturday Jan 15th 8 AM the breeze more
 moderate at 4 kept S. by E with all sail
 set latter part calm Sat obs 45:14
 Song by acct 137:30 W

Sunday Jan 16th 8 AM calm and cloudy
 bundle sun - bone and stood it away middle
 part light air from S.E. latter the wind came to
 the north steered by S. tacks aboard saw a ship
 standing to S. eastward with studdingsails set
 Sat est 44:50
 Song est 137:50 W

Monday Jan 17th 8 AM brisk breeze and flying
 clouds from the north steering by S. tacks
 aboard with all sail set at 12 wore ship to E.S.E.
 latter part fresh gale and rain double reef the
 top sails Sat est 44:40
 Song est 135:50 W
