 high breeze from N eastward at 6 AM raised
 Cayhee Dist 8 miles latter brisk breeze from
 the N eastward steering the same

Saturday March 11th 8 PM (Raised
 Mower bearing N.W. by W Dist 30 miles
 at 7 we were up to the east point brisk
 breeze and fine weather from the eastward
 latter the weather much the same
 Demon head in sight

Tuesday April 3rd 1848
 8 PM a fine fresh breeze from
 N.E. so ends

Wednesday April 4th at 3 got
 under way with fine fresh breeze
 from N.E. from W by N middle
 all hands employed in stowing anchors
 and chains steering S by N compass
 middle and steering by stacks aboard
 under double reef top sails blowing fresh
 from N.E.

Thursday April 5th 1848
 8 PM fresh gale from
 N.E. steering by stacks aboard the island
 of Atary in sight on the lee beam
 middle and latter parts blowing fresh
 on board the main sail and canvas repairing
 it
 Sat obs 23.29 W
 Song by Chron 159.32

Friday April 6th 8 PM the gale continues
 much the same steering by under double
 reefed top sails stacks the watch employed
 in repairing the main sail middle and
 latter part the weather much the same
 employed in repairing the main sail
 Sat obs 24 05
 Song by Chron 160.04 W

Saturday April 8th 8 PM fresh breeze
 from N.W. steering by stacks aboard under
 double reef top sails the watch employed
 in repairing the main sail at 8 AM set
 all sail and took in 3 Boat and
 repaired her light breeze and fine weather
 Sat obs 24 53
 Song by Chron 160.53

Sunday April 9th 8 PM fine weather
 from the north steering by stacks
 aboard middle and latter equally and
 baffling wind steering by on different tacks
 Sat est 25.10 W
 Song est 161.08 W
