

Thursday May 18th 1848

P.M. fresh gale and lowry from
S.E. lying under double reef main top sail and fore
sail heading to the south middle and latter parts
the weather continues much the same saw No whale
Sat obs 51-42 W
Long est 160-30 W

Friday May 19th P.M. fresh gale and foggy
from S.E. lying under close reef main top sail
and fore sail heading to the Westward middle
and latter parts light breeze and thick fog set
double reef top sail no obs

Saturday May 20th P.M. light breeze
and thick fog from S.E. were ship to
the S.W. under double reef top sails at 1 saw
A. R. whale middle and latter parts fresh gale and
rain from N.E. no obs

Sunday May 21st P.M. fresh gale and rain
from S.E. steering by S. tack aboard at 7
took in fore and mizzen top sails saw No
whale turn flukes at 12 M the wind came to
south at 11 A.M. set fore and mizzen top sails
Sat obs 51-25
Long by Chron 160-33

Monday May 22nd P.M. light breeze and
frequent squalls of fog from S.E. at 4 saw
S. ship and that her boats were past to S. whale
by her moving at 5 we were ship to the eastward
at 10 were to the eastward, at 11 A.M. were to the westward
latter fresh gale and lowry from S.E. the last
mentioned sail in sight Sat obs 51-53
Long by Chron 159 51 W

Tuesday May 23rd 1848

P.M. fresh gale and lowry
from S.E. steering by S. tack aboard under double
reef top sails the last mentioned sail in sight
at 7 took in fore and mizzen top sails and were ship
to the westward middle and latter fresh gale
Sat obs 52-11 W
Long by Chron 159-30 W

Wednesday May 24th P.M. were ship to the
S.E. and set fore top sail the above mentioned
sail in sight fresh gale from S.W. at 9 A.M.
struck and drew from No whale at 10 got pretty
fast to and other and drew latter light breeze
and fine weather from N.W. Sat obs 51-35
Long by Chron 159-10

Thursday May 25th P.M. at 5 lowered
and struck No whale and sunk him at 8
double reefed the top sails light breeze
from the south middle light breeze latter
fresh gale and rain from S.E. at 9 A.M.
kept of W by compass no obs

Friday May 26th P.M. fresh gale and
rain from S.E. at 1-30 took in all sail
but a close reef main top sail and the anc
luffed to at 4 the wind came to S.E. and
moraled at 7 A.M. the wind came to the S.W.
and blowed on fresh gale and a heavy swell up
no obs

Saturday May 27th P.M. fresh gale and
heavy swell on from S.W. lying under close
reef main top sail and fore sail heading to
S.W. middle the weather continues the same
latter calm and hazy Sat obs 51-43 W
Long by Chron 160-24 W
