

Sunday May 28th 1848

P.M. light air from the south raised R whale and chaisted but without success at 8 double reefed the top sails and wore ship to S.W. latter fresh gale from S.W. and clear weather Sat obs 51.52.

Monday May 29th P.M. wore ship to S.E. fresh gale from S.W. and clear weather at 8 A.M. kept of N.E. raised two R whales lowered and chaisted but they were gone quick kept of again latter fresh gale from S.W. Sat obs 51.54
Long by Chron 160.33

Tuesday May 30th P.M. fresh gale from S.W. at 1 saw one R whale gone quick the rest of the day steering different courses at 7.30 shortened sail at 10 wore ship to the N.W. latter fresh gale from S.W. plenty of whales lowered twice without success Sat obs 51.58
Long by Chron 160.11

Wednesday May 31st P.M. more moderate set whale top sails at 3 lowered and chaisted 5 shot the whales as the Seville at 7.30 double reefed the top sails nearly calm and fine weather at 10 wore ship to the N.E. at 7.4 P.M. set all sail latter light breeze and rain from N.E.

Thursday May June 1st 1848
P.M. light breeze and thick fog from S.E. steering by S tack aboard at 6 took in fore and mizzen top sails and wore ship to the north middle and latter calm and fog.

Friday June 2nd 1848

P.M. calm and foggy middle part the wind light and latter thick lowry weather steered W.S.W. at 8 A.M. the fog lifted up saw R whale and chaisted but without success latter light air from S.W. and fine weather

Saturday June 3rd P.M. light breeze and sun hazy from S.W. steering by one different tacks with all sail set at 7 struck and sunk a whale middle and latter part light breeze and lowry at 8 kept of the wind from S.
Sat obs 51.38
Long est 160.40.17

Sunday June 4th P.M. thick lowry weather from S steering by S tacks aboard at 8 double reefed the top sails nearly calm at 11 P.M. took light breeze from S.W. kept of N.E. at 8 lowered for R whale but without success latter brisk breeze and sun fog from W steering S.E. with all sail set
Sat obs 51.43

Monday June 5th P.M. fresh breeze from W steering S.E. by compass with all sail set at 8 double reefed the top sails and wore to the south at 9 comes on fresh gale and rain took in fore top sail and close reefed the main latter heavy gale from W.S.W. lying to under close reef main top sail heading to the south
