

Friday June 16th 1848
 at 3 lowered for R whale
 and started at him but he was too fair of
 at 8 double reefed the top sails fresh gale
 and thick fog from the westward middle
 took in fore and mizzen top sails at 8 wore ship
 to the westward latter fresh gale from S.W.
 Sat obs 51-58
 Long by Chron 155-44

Saturday June 17th P.M. the weather continues
 the same lying under double reef main top sail
 and fore sail at 9 A.M. kept of R.C. by N light
 breeze and low from S.W. ends the same
 Sat obs 51-58 N
 Long by Chron 155-02 W

Sunday June 18th P.M. the weather the
 same steering N.E. by N at 7 lowered for two R
 whales and one Boat, got stove and never
 started at the whale took her long side and heaved
 her on deck at 10 A.M. lowered for three more
 but without success
 Sat obs 52-17
 no obs

Monday June 19th P.M. light breeze and
 hazy from the south steering N.E. by E with all
 sail set at 5 comes in thick fog at 8 double
 reefed the top sails and kept N.E. by W at 5 A.M.
 set all sail and heaved to the wind to N.E. by E
 latter light breeze and fine weather Sat obs 53-17
 Long by Chron 153-39 W

Tuesday June 20th
 at 3 P.M. lowered for two R whales
 but without success light breeze and fine
 from E steering by Stacks aboard latter part
 fresh gale and rain from S.E.
 no obs

Wednesday June 21st 1848 153
 P.M. the breeze falls to calm and
 heavy swell on latter the same Sat obs 53-35
 Long est 153-40

Thursday June 22nd P.M. light breeze from
 the westward set all sail and kept N.E.
 at 8 comes in thick fog at 8 double reefed the
 fore and mizzen top sails middle and latter free
 breeze and hazy from the westward steering the
 same Sat obs 54-10
 Long est 150-40

Friday June 23rd P.M. light breeze and
 fog from S.W. steering N.E. and S.E. latter
 the weather much the same Sat obs 54-24
 Long by Chron 150-45

Saturday June 24th P.M. light breeze and
 thick fog from S.W. steering N.E. with all
 sail set at 7 kept N.E. by E saw three R
 whales to thick to lower double reefed the top sails
 and heaved to at 4 A.M. raised fore R whales
 at 6 raised fore more at 9 the fog lifted up
 lowered and started against one jaw Bone at
 10 thick fog so ends the day no obs

Sunday June 25th at 1 P.M. the
 fog lifted up plenty of R whales at 2 lowered
 but without success at 3 thick fog again
 and rain from S.E. steering by Stacks aboard
 middle fresh gale took in fore and mizzen
 top sails latter nearby calm and thick
 fog lying under double reef main top sail
 and fore sail no obs
