Thursday July 27th P.M. calm and thick fog all hands employed in hauling out at 12 finish latter calm and thick fog all hands employed in stowing down
 no obs

Friday July 28th P.M. light breeze from N.W. all hands employed in stowing down latter fresh breeze and thick fog

Saturday July 29th P.M. fresh breeze and thick fog from N.W. at 4 finish stowing down the whale middle and latter part thick fog

Sunday July 30th P.M. hited up kept of E at 4 raised R whale lowered but without success middle and latter parts light breeze and cloudy from the westward steering by on different tacks Sat. est 55:10

 P.M. light breeze and fine weather at 3 raised R whale lowered and struck and drawn at 8 took in sail steering E latter fresh breeze and cloudy from S.W. steering E with top sails set

Tuesday August 1st 1848
 P.M. fresh breeze and cloudy from S.W. steering N by W under top sails at 3 took in fore and mizzen top sails at 8 luffed to N.W. latter part fresh breeze and haze from N.W. steering by 8 tacks aboard under double reef top sails and courses
 no obs

Wednesday Aug 2nd P.M. the weather continues the same steering by 8 tacks aboard at 8 took in Jib and main sail latter part fresh gale and rain from S double reefed the top sails and took in Jib and main sail
 no obs

Thursday Aug 3rd P.M. fresh gale and rain from S steering by 8 tacks aboard under double reef top sails at 4 A.M. wore ship to Eastward latter part light breeze from S steering by 8 tacks aboard with all sail set at 6 saw two R whales gone quick to the south
 Sat. obs 56-24 N

Friday Aug 4th P.M. nearly calm and cloudy at 10 light breeze from N.W. kept S.E. at 9 A.M. lowered for R whales but without success latter fresh breeze from the N.W. running for two more whales
 Sat. obs 55-51 N

Saturday Aug 5th P.M. lowered for two R whales but without success at 5 lowered again the same result at 8 double reefed the top sails one sail in sight light breeze and fine weather latter part brisk breeze and fog from N.W. saw one R whale to fair to the windward to try him
