loose from SW steering by stacks aboard
at 9 took in fore and mizzen top sails middle
fresh gale and rain from SW latter the wind
came to the westward and blowed fresh gale and
clear weather

fresh gale and fine weather from the westward
lying under double reef main top sail and
fore sail middle and latter moderate and thick
foggy from the westward

weather from the westward steering by stacks
a-head with all sail set at 7 double reefed the
top sails latter part the weather continues the
same

south and thick foggy steering by on different
tacks at 7 double reefed the top sails at 10
wore to the westward latter fresh gale and thick foggy
weather at 11 wore to the south and set top and
main sail

Thursday Aug 10th 8^{pm} light breeze from
the westward steering by stacks aboard at 4-30
took in top and main sail latter part fresh
gale and loose from the westward one sail in
sight to the eastward

at 4^{pm} spoke the ship
Remon New Bedford capt Blackmore 6 whales
this season at 8 double reefed the top sails
light breeze and fine weather from the westward
latter part fresh breeze and thick foggy from south

Saturday Aug 12th 8^{pm} fresh breeze and
thick foggy from south steering by stacks
tacks aboard under double reefed top sails at
6 wore ship to the south eastward at 4^{pm}
wore ship to NW latter fresh gale and thick
foggy

Sunday Aug 13th 8^{pm} fresh breeze and
thick foggy from NW steering by stacks
aboard under double reefed top sails at 9 wore
ship to south latter part light breeze and fine
weather

Sat obs 55-14

Monday Aug 14th 8^{pm} kept of NNE light
breeze and fine weather from the westward plenty
of finbacks in sight at 7-30 double reefed the
top sails and luffed to to NNE at 7^{pm} rain
the whale lowered and chaired but without success spoke
the Remon latter fresh breeze and foggy from NW

Tuesday Aug 15th 8^{pm} wore ship to the south
fresh breeze and loose from SW at 7-30 double reefed
the top sails saw whale turn flukes at 7^{pm}
struck the whale and had to put on account the
foggy latter saw several whales
