

Wednesday August 16th 1848

Nm fresh breeze and hazy from SSW
saw 3 whales and chased in company
with the Roman Boats at 9 were
Ship to S.E. at 1 P.M. were to N.W. latter
fresh gale from S.W. Sat obs 55-49
Long by Chron 139-54

Thursday Aug 17th Nm fresh gale from
S.W. steering by S tacks aboard under double
reef top sails at 9 were Ship to the south at 1 P.M.
were to N.W. and set the S.E. latter fresh gale
from S.W. Sat obs 56-64 N
Long by Chron 139-55

Friday Aug 18th Nm fresh gale from
S.W. steering by S tacks aboard under double
reef top sails and S.E. latter part more moderate
set whole top sails no obs

Saturday Aug 19th Nm were Ship to
the westward fresh breeze from the south
at 7 double reefed the top sails middle
part fresh gale and rain from S.E. latter
calm and fog and heavy swell on
Sat obs 55-58
Long by Chron 140-42

Sunday Aug 20th at 1 P.M. took a heavy
gale from the westward took in fore sail
and close reefed main top sail and were
to the south one sail in sight to the S.E.
middle and latter part continues heavy gale
from the south at 1 P.M. were Ship to the
westward Sat obs 55-56 N
Long by Chron 140-28
Long by lunar obs 140-29

Monday August 21st 1848

Nm fresh gale from
south lying under close reef main top sail
tacks aboard latter more moderate and the wind came
to the eastward no obs

Tuesday Aug 22nd Nm light breeze from the
eastward set double reefed top sails steering by S
tacks aboard plenty of finbacks in sight at 9 A.M.
lowered and chased 3 R. whales but without
success latter light breeze and heavy swell on from
the north Sat obs 55-48
Long by Chron 140-16

Wednesday 23rd Nm light breeze and fine
weather from the north chased the same
whales again the same result at 7 double
reefed the top sails one sail in sight
middle light breeze and fine weather at 10 A.M.
raised two R. whales gone quick to the westward
chased them in company with the Roman
Boats latter light air from S.W. Sat obs 55-48

Thursday Aug 24th Nm light air from
S.W. fine weather steering by S tacks
aboard the Roman in sight astern at 7
double reefed the top sails middle fine weather
latter light breeze from N.E. kept 9 no obs

Friday Aug 25th Nm nearly calm at 7 double
reefed the top sails at 10 took light breeze from
the eastward steered by S tacks aboard at 1 P.M.
were Ship to the south brisk breeze from the
eastward at 11 A.M. lowered and struck a whale
ends with fresh breeze the Boat fast to the whale
and the other two chasing no obs
