Saturday Sept 26th P.M. fresh gale from the south steering by under double reef top sails and courses the watch employed variously middle squally at 4 A.M. took light air from the north kept S by W with all sail set

Sunday Sept 27th P.M. light breeze and flying clouds from the north steering S by W with all sail set the watch employed in repairing sails at 9 the breeze falls to a calm at 1 A.M. the wind came to the south and comes on fresh gale took in top g sails and double reefed the top sails latter part fresh gale and squally steering by S tacks aboard

P.M. fresh gale and flying clouds from the south steering by S tacks aboard under double reef top sails and fore sail at 8 A.M. wore ship to S.W. the gale increases at 11 took in fore and mizzen top sails latter heavy gale from south

Tuesday Sept 26th P.M. fresh gale from the south lying under close reef main top sail and fore sail heading to W.W.W. middle and latter parts the weather continues the same

Wednesday Sept 27th at 3 P.M. more moderate set fore and mizzen top sails double reefed fresh gale from the south steering by S tacks aboard under double reef top sails and fore sail middle and latter set whole top sails jib and courses the wind continues the same

Thursday Sept 28th P.M. fresh gale from south and flying clouds steering by S tacks aboard under top sails and courses heading from S.W. to W.S.W. middle and latter part more moderate set main top g sail the watch employed in repairing sails

Friday Sept 29th P.M. moderate breeze and fine weather from the south the watch employed in repairing sails at 4 wore ship to the S.E. middle and latter the weather continues much the same the watch employed variously
