Tuesday Dec 19th P.M. light air from
the eastward and fine weather steering
by S, E with all sail set the watch employed
in Ship Duty middle and latter nearly
calm and fine weather Lat Obs 24-28 S
Long by Chron 158-45 W
Long by Lunars 159-13 W

Wednesday Dec 20th P.M. light breeze from
S, E steering by with all sail set S, tacks
aboard the watch employed in Ship Duty
middle and latter the weather continues the same
Lat Obs 24-28 S
Long by Chron 159-35 W

Thursday Dec 21th P.M. light breeze and
fine weather from Seaward steering by
S, tacks aboard with all sail set middle and
latter parts the weather continues the same
Lat Obs 26-08
Long by Chron 160-20 W

Friday Dec 22nd 1848
P.M. light breeze and
fine weather from the Seaward steering by
S, tacks aboard with all sail set the watch
employed in Ship Duty latter fresh gale
from the S, E took in fore and mizzen top
g sails Lat Obs 27-08
Long by Chron 160:50

Saturday Dec 23rd P.M. fresh gale and flying
clouds from the S, E steering by S, tacks
aboard with main top g sail set the watch
employed in Ship Duty middle and latter
parts the weather continues the same
no obs

Sunday Dec 24th P.M. fresh gale
and flying clouds from Seaward steering
by S, tacks aboard with fore and main
top g sails set the watch employed in
Ship Duty middle part the breeze increases
took in fore top g sail and single reefed fore
top sail Lat Obs 31-46
Long by Chron 163:50

Monday Dec 25th P.M. fresh gale
and fine weather from the S, E double
reefed the top sails steering by S, tacks aboard
at 10 A.M. set whole fore and main top sails
and main top g sail fresh gale and flying
clouds from the Seaward one sail in
sight on the weather quarter called it the
Columbus Fairhaven Lat Obs 35:05
