P.M. heavy gale and cloudy
from S, E lying under close reef main top sail
and fore sail I took aboard heading from
E, S, E to N, E middle moderate set all
sail latter nearly calm and fine weather

Friday Jan 19th P.M. took light breeze
from the north steering E by N bent an new
main top sail and an new fore top g sail
and shifted fore top sails light breeze
and fine weather from the north middle
thick fog latter the weather much the same
steering E by N with studding sails set

Sat est 47-17.9

Saturday Jan 20th P.M. the breeze
came to W, S, W and fine weather steering
E with all sail set the watch employed
variously middle and latter light breeze and
fine weather from the south

Sunday Jan 21st P.M. light breeze
and fine weather from the south steering
E with all sail set the employed in ship
duty middle and latter parts moderate
gale and flying clouds from the westward

Sat Obs 47-39.9

Song est 134-35 W

Monday January 22nd 1849

P.M. fresh gale
and flying clouds from the westward steering
E with top g, studding sails set and fore top
mast studding middle comes on heavy gale
and rain from N, W double reefed fore and mizzen
top sails at 9 A.M. double reefed main top sail
and took in the mizzen latter heavy gale and rain

Sat est 48-00

Song est 132-10 W

Tuesday Jan 23rd P.M. the wind
came to W, S, W and clear
of fine and heavy gale steering E under double
reef top sails and fore sail middle and latter
parts the gale continues the same set whole
fore and main top sails and main top g sail

Sat Obs 48-23

Wednesday Jan 24th P.M. took in main
top g sail and double reefed fore top strong
gale from S, W and frequent squalls of rain
steering E by compass under whole main top
and double reef fore and mizzen and fore sail
middle the wind came to the north and moderate
set studding sails at 10 A.M. the gale increases
took in studding sails latter blowing heavy
gale from the north

Sat Obs 48-48

Thursday Jan 25th P.M. the gale continues
the same steering E with top g sails set
the gale continues the same and frequent
squalls of rain
