P.M. brisk breeze and fine weather from the westward steering E by N by compass with all sail set the watch employed in Ship Duty middle thick lowry weather latter light breeze and cloudy

Monday February 5th P.M. brisk breeze and fine weather from the westward steering E by N with all sail set middle the wind veants to N.W. and come on fresh gale and lowry took in main & studding sail and mizzen top & sail latter fresh gale and thick lowry weather

Long by chron 86.40 W

Tuesday February 6th P.M. the wind veants to the westward clears of sun steering E by N by compass fore top mast sail set at 7 set top & studding sails middle and latter pleasant gale from the westward bent an new fly jib

Wednesday February 7th N.W. pleasant gale and frequent showers of rain from the westward steering E by N with all sail set at 4 kept E by N the watch employed in rigging lowers studding sail middle and latter part light breeze and fine weather from the westward set lowers studding sail

Thursday February 8th 1849

P.M. light breeze and fine weather from the westward steering E by N with studding sails set low and aloft at 4 kept E by N the watch employed in Ship Duty at 8 A.M. kept E fresh gale from S.W. at 9 saw a Brig running to the eastward

Friday February 9th at 3 P.M. raised the Jib of Diego Ramirez bearing E.N.E. Dist 30 miles at 7 the Land bearing W.N.W. Dist 15 miles the above mentioned sail in sight ahead fresh gale from S.W. steering E.N.E. by compass under double reefed fore and mizzen top sails and main top & sail at 6 A.M. set all sail studding sails low and aloft at 8 kept N.E. by compass latter calm

Saturday February 10th at 3 P.M. took breeze from the N.E. steered by stacks aboard heading E by N with top & sails set on bent for top mast stay sail and repaired and bent it again at 8 took in top & sails and double reefed the fore and mizzen top sails fresh gale and rain from N.E. latter light airs and lowry from N.N.E.

Sunday February 11th P.M. light airs from N.N.E. steering by stacks aboard with all sail set middle the wind veants to S.W. set studding sails low and aloft latter pleasant gale from the W.S.W. steering N.N.E. by compass
