P.M. pleasant gales from W, S.W. and fine weather steering N.E. by N. with studding sails set low and aloft at 3 raised sail head middle the wind came to the south and increased to a gale latter fresh gale and flying clouds from the south

Tuesday Feb 13th P.M. fresh gale and flying clouds from the south steering

N.E. by N. with fore top mast studding sail set and main top & studding sail middle the wind came to S.W. latter fresh breeze from S.W. steering N.E. with studding set aloft and aloft

Wednesday Feb 14th P.M. comes on fresh gale and rain from the westward took in studding sails steering N.E. with top & sails set at 8 A.M. kept N.E. by N. latter more moderate set studding sails low and aloft

Thursday Feb 15th at 3 P.M. the gale increased took in studding sails at 10 took in top & sails and double reefed fore and mizzen top sails and single reefed the main blowing a hard gale and harder squalls from S.W. steering N.E. by N. latter part the gale continues the same and a heavy sea on

Friday February 16th 1849

P.M. heavy gale and frequent squalls from S.W. steering N.E. by N. under double reef fore and mizzen top sails and single reef main and fore sail latter part more moderate set studding sails

Saturday Feb 17th P.M. brisk breeze and fine weather from the S.W. steering N.E. by N. with studding sails low and left the watch employed in Ship Duty middle the wind came to N.W. took in top and top & studding sails and fore and top & sails latter fresh gale and fine weather

Saturday Feb 18th P.M. fresh gale and pleasant weather from S.W. steering N.E. by N. at 4 split the fore sail and took it in and double reefed the top sail at 5 took in main top & sail at 9 A.M. double reefed main top sail latter heavy gale from the westward

Monday Feb 19th P.M. heavy gale from the westward steering N.E. by N. under double reef top sails split and main sail at 4 left one reef out main top sail middle set all sail latter calm and fine weather bent anew and fore sail
