

Wednesday February 28th 1849

P.M. comes on squally and rain from N.W. took in top & sails and double reefed the top sails at 4 nearly calm and cloudy middle comes on fresh gale and frequent showers latter the weather continues the same steering by under double reefed top and Lib. Tacks aboard

Thursday Feb 29th P.M. fresh gale from the north steering by under double reef top sails Tacks aboard middle and latter the ~~can~~ wind all round the compass and calms and raining in torrents Sat est 31:00
Long est 30:40

Friday March 1st 1849

P.M. rain and whorle winds in all quarters took in all sail but double reef main top at 4 the breeze more steady from S.E. set fore sail steering N and still raining in torrents at 6 A.M. set whole main top sail Lib. and main sail and double reef fore and mizzen top sails at 9 the wind came to N.W. and comes on heavy squalls took in all sail but double reef main top and fore sail the Lib. sheet parted and split the sail latter fresh gale and heavy heading E.N.E. in obs

Saturday March 3rd P.M. set double reef top sails at 3 wore ship to N.W. fresh gale and a heavy swell on from N.W. and heavy middle and latter heavy gales and calms Thunder and lightning and raining in torrents the wind from the north steering by in different Tacks under double reef top sails Sat obs 29:56
Long by chron 31:31

Sunday March 4th 1849

P.M. fresh gale and rain from N.W. steering by Tacks aboard under double reef top sails Thunder and lightning middle heavy squalls and calms took in fore top sail and set it 3 or 4 times raining in torrents all the time latter the weather continues the same no obs

Monday March 5th P.M. calm and rain Thunder and lightning at 4 light air from the eastward steered N by E middle heavy squalls and rain latter more moderate set whole main top sail and main top & sail sent new Lib. and set it light breeze from S.W. steering by Tacks aboard no obs

Tuesday March 6th P.M. the weather continues the same steering by Tacks aboard with all sail set at 4 sun rain from N.W. a very new thin in this place middle comes on heavy gale took top & sail and double reefed the top sails latter fresh gale from N.W. Sat obs 27:55
Long by chron 28:55

Wednesday March 7th P.M. fresh gale and heavy swell from N.W. steering by Tacks aboard under double reef top sails Lib. and main sail at 8 wore ship to N.W. more moderate middle and latter light breeze and clear weather and a heavy swell on from N.W. steering by Tacks aboard with all sail set
