

Thursday March 8th 1849—

at 2 PM wore ship to the eastward light breeze and heavy swell on from NNE steering by S tacks aboard with all sail set one sail in sight on the weather bow at 1 AM tack ship to NW latter light breeze and fine weather from NNE

Friday March 9th PM light air inclining to calm from NEastward steering by S tacks aboard with all sail set the watch employed in Ship Duty at 9 took light breeze from the eastward set studding sails and kept N by E latter fresh breeze from SE

Sat obs 28:31.5

Saturday March 10th PM fresh gale from SE steering N by E with studding sails set low and aloft the watch employed variously middle part the wind came more to the eastward took in lower studding sail latter fresh gale and heavy squalls from the eastward at 4 PM saw a sail standing to SW

Sunday March 11th PM fresh gale from the eastward steering N by E with fore top mast studding set one sail in sight of the lee beam standing the same as when air latter light breeze and fine weather from the eastward steering NNE

Sat obs 28:50.5

Monday March 12th 1849

PM light breeze and fine weather from Eastward steering NNE with all sail set studding sails low and aloft one sail in sight on the lee beam at 4:30 kept NNE by N by E middle the wind next hour of N by E latter came up NNE light breeze and fine weather Sat obs 22:19

Tuesday March 13th PM light breeze and fine weather from the eastward steering NNE by N with all sail set one sail in sight of the lee bow the watch employed in Ship Duty at 6 AM raised the Isle Sand of Trinidad bearing NNE by E Dist 45 miles latter light breeze and fine weather from the eastward the Isle Sand on the weather bow and one sail in sight of the lee quarter

Sat obs 24:00.5

Wednesday March 14th PM light breeze and fine weather from the eastward steering by S tacks aboard with all sail set the Isle Sand and the sail in sight at 5 kept NNE the Sand bearing E by N Dist 18 miles middle and latter light breeze and fine weather from ENE to E steering NNE with all sail set the watch employed in Ship Duty Sat obs 19:57
