P.M. calm the watch employed in painting the spars to the above mentioned Bark in sight and one other sail on side and latter light airs from the south 2 sails in sight

Monday M. April 2<sup>nd</sup> P.M. light breeze from S.W. steering N by E 1/2 E at 4 the breeze falls to a calm and cloudy 3 sails in sight middle the wind light and baffling and heavy showers of rain latter light airs from N.W.

P.M. the breeze falls to calm one Bark and Brig in sight middle and latter light baffling winds and calms the watch employed in washing ship. Sat Obs 2:00 E

Wednesday April 4<sup>th</sup> P.M. light baffling winds and calms the watch employed in washing ship the last mentioned Bark in sight to the north middle and latter parts raining in torrents the all round the compass and calms no obs

Thursday April 5<sup>th</sup> P.M. raining in torrents and the wind light and baffling the above mentioned Bark in sight 1/2 at 2 miles middle light baffling and rain at 9 A.M. Capt. Sayre came on board from the Clement latter raining in torrents

Friday April 6<sup>th</sup> P.M. took light air from the south kept N by W with studding sails low and left the Clement in company, at 3-30 the breeze came to N.E. and fell nearly to a calm middle and latter brisk breeze and some showers of rain from N.E. steering by S. tacks aboard no obs

Saturday April 7<sup>th</sup> P.M. P.M. light breeze and cloudy from N.E. to N.E. steering by S. tacks aboard with all sail set the above mentioned Bark in company middle and latter brisk breeze from E.N.E. steering N by W
