P.M. fresh N.E. trays steering S.W. with top mast and top of studding sails set the watch employed in painting the latter the breeze came to E.N.E. set lower studding sail Sat Obs 13:16.8

Saturday April 14th P.M. brisk breeze from E.N.E. steering S.W. by stacks with studding set low and left the watch employed in painting in side the ship the middle and latter light breeze from S.E.

Sunday April 15th P.M. light breeze and pleasant weather from S.E. steering S.W. by compass with studding set low and left middle and latter light breeze and fine weather
