

Thursday May 3rd 1849

Wm comes on fresh gale
from NNE took in fore and mizzen top
g sails and single reefed fore and mizzen
top sails steering by S tacks aboard saw
a Schooner standing to Eastward at 7 took
in main top g sail and single reefed main
top sail saw a Bark standing to the south
at 9 Am set all sail latter light breeze
and fine weather from NNE steering by S tacks
aboard

Sat 64 38° 04' N
Long by Chron 76: 13 W

Friday May 4th Wm light light air
and fine weather from NE steering
by with all sail set at 8 the wind came to S.W.
set studding sails low and close latter the weather
continues the same saw 3 Ships Sat 64 40: 18 N
Long by Chron 76: 45 W

Saturday May 5th Wm fresh breeze from
S.W steering by W by W by W with studding set
saw one Ship and Brig standing to Eastward
at 5 raised Montock Point bearing N Dist
15 miles at 6 bore up for Block Isle Land
middle light baffling winds with thunder
and lightning at 12 M Block Isle bearing
N Dist 4 miles kept ENE the wind came to
to NE and lowry at 4 Am took a Pilot
two Ships in company one the Charles and
the others Sytogue
