

Thursday Aug. 19. 1851.

These 24 hours begins with moderate breeze from the E.S.E. to E.S.E. at 4 P.M. breezy on took in the light sails at 5 set double reef top sails, at 6 took in jib and main sail at 8 P.M. took in the fore top sail, close reef the main have too, heading S.E. Having a strong gale accompanied with rain. The middle part of E.S.E. the latter part of N.E. wind increase took in the fore sail, to end
Lat. 51° 30' N. Long 161° 00' E.

Friday Aug. 20.

These 24 hours begins with strong gale from the North ship have too, heading from E.S.E. to N.E. at 4 P.M. the gale breaks, at 7 P.M. ship set the fore sail and main spencer, heading S. by E. the middle part from moderate at 8 a.m. set all sail, shivered by the wind to the N.W. saw nothing. Lat. 51° 54' N. Long 161° 53' E.

Saturday Aug. 21.

These 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the N.W. ship under all sail shivering by the wind to the South. at 7 P.M. set double reef top sails, the middle and latter parts strong gale with thick rainy weather, at 10 P.M. took in jib and main sail, saw nothing, heading N. Lat. 51° 52' N. Long 160° 14' E.

Sunday Aug. 22.

begins with strong gale from the S.E. accompanied with thick rainy weather, ship under double reef top sails, heading N. at 3 P.M. wore ship, to the S.E. took in the fore top sail, close reef the main set to up S.E. the middle part begins to moderate at 7 a.m. set double reef top sails, wore ship to the N.W. by 10 P.M. ship under whole top sail, Lat. 52° 00' N. Long 160° 20' E.

Monday Aug. 23.

These 24 hours begins with light breeze from the N.W. ship under all sail shivering by the wind to the N.W. at 6 P.M. saw a whale going quick to the westward, loomed & boat and chaired, at sun set came on board, laved in light wind S.W. the middle part broke breeze from N. to N.E. the latter part calm saw 2 ships, and plenty of fire smoke, but no R. Whales, ship close in with the land. Lat. 52° 35' N. Long 159° 40' E.

Sunday Aug. 24. 1851.

These 24 hours begins with light breeze from the S.W. ship under all sail shivering by the wind to the S.W. at 2 P.M. spoke ship, Rosses, of S.P.M. & whale went on board, at 3 P.M. heavy squalls from the North, put the ship under double reef, at 7 hauled up S.E. wind N.E. and sharp lightning. The middle part wind came to the N.W. the latter part strong gale from the N.W. at 4 a.m. saw a ship make sail, and steer off E.S.E. at 12 P.M. passed a ship, a sailing ship, under double reef top sails, shivering by the wind to the S.W. Lat. 51° 48' N. Long 159° 40' E.

Tuesday Aug. 25.

These 24 hours begins with fresh gale from the N.W. ship under double reef top sails, shivering by the wind to the N.W. at 2 P.M. spoke ship, William Thompson, a sailing, saw plenty of fire smoke, no R. Whales. The middle part wind came to the S.W. and S.W. at 12 P.M. took ship to the N.W. at 4 a.m. saw a ship, at 7 a.m. up S.W. by N. the latter part thick and rainy ship under all sail shivering by the wind at 9 a.m. took ship to the Eastward at 11 P.M. took in top and main sail, at 12 P.M. double reef the top sails, wind S.W. saw nothing, no observation.

Wednesday Aug. 26.

These 24 hours begins with strong gale from the S.E. accompanied with thick rainy weather, at 2 P.M. took in jib and main sail at 8 P.M. took in the fore top sail, close reef the main, ship head S. by N.E. the middle part begins to moderate at 2 P.M. wind shifted to the Westward, ship at 12 P.M. the latter part strong breeze, with fog at 9 a.m. made sail, shivered by the wind to the S.W. by S. saw nothing. Lat. 51° 40' N. Long 159° 00' E.

Thursday Aug. 27.

These 24 hours begins with strong breeze from the N.W. ship under whole top sails, shivering by the wind to the N.W. at sun set saw a whale going quick to the westward, set down a R. Whale, at 7 P.M. set double reef top sails, the middle part continues much the same, the latter part moderate, with thick fog at 11 a.m. lifted up main sail, shivering by the wind to the N.W. saw nothing, wind from N.W. to N.E. so ends this day and page.
