Wednesday 30th Sept. 1840

Comd. with strong gales S.W. and moderate
breeze the same Lat 40.25 Long 57.25

Thursday Oct. 1st 1840

Comd. strong gales N.W. and lightning latter
breeze reefed the top Lat 41.30 Long 54.39

Friday Oct. 2nd

Comd. with strong winds N. under double reef
top. Made the same latter moderated made
all sail large ship to land No Obs.

Saturday Oct. 3rd

Comd. with fresh gales N.E. the ship still
to land. Wind & latter the same No Obs. Lat 39

Sunday 4th Oct.

Comd. with fresh gales from E. & N.E. two ships
in sight. latter part passed a ship bound west.

Monday Oct. 5th

Comd. fresh gales E. & N.E. on the wind S.E. and
latter the same saw a finback. Lat 38 54.2.46 41

Tuesday 6th Oct.

Comd. with fresh gales from E. & N.E. and gale
Wind took in top galls latter squally double
reefed the top. No ends

Wednesday 7th Oct.

Comd. heavy gales from E. handed the gale &
mainsail 24 more ship & stood to the N.E.
Wind & latter heavy squalls with rain No ends

Thursday Oct. 8th

Comd. heavy gales E. & N.E. and rainy latter moderate
set Mr. W. galls sail Lat 38.44 Long 46.5

Friday Oct. 9th

Comd. strong gales and squalls of wind from E.
on the wind S.E. and double reefed the top latter
heavy gale took in galls & mainsail Lat 39.57 Long 46.6

From Plymouth Towards the N. Island

Sat. Oct. 10th 1840

Comd. with heavy gales & squally from E.
steering on the wind N. & N.E. moderate
lacked and stood E. & N.E. latter do Lat 40.00 Long 44.7

Sunday Oct. 11th

First part wind shifted N.W. steering
E. 24 Mr. cabin 28 double reefed the top took in
gt. & mainsail & 6 hours her too blowing away
from N.E. and raining. So ends No Obs.

Monday Oct. 12

Heavy gales and rainy & 6 clouds reefed the
Mr. W. heading. S.E. 29 cabin 23 & 16 light
breeze sprung up from S.W. latter side top galls
So ends Lat 40.35 Long 42.00

Tuesday Oct. 13th

Comd. with strong gales S.W. and rainy took
in top galls & 6 double reefed the top 27 hours
her too. Wind heavy squalls and rainy turned up
the sea boats latter the same 21 kept her off
under double reefed the top & for sail Lat 41.20 Long 41.00

Wednesday Oct. 14

Comd. with heavy gales N. & N.W. & 1 P.M. set the
fortop 25 Mr. top galls sail covered & saw finback
Wind & latter fine employed in breaching out for ship
Lat 42.17 Long 38.10

Thursday Oct. 15

Comd. with fine breeze from S.W. & 1 P.M. set
course E. Wind wind shifted to N. latter S.E. in
in setting up rigging Lat 42.43 Long 36.03 W.

Friday Oct. 16th

Comd. with light breeze E. & N.E. and latter
the same So ends Lat 41.37 Long 35.51

Saturday Oct. 17th

Comd. with strong gales E. & N.E. and cloudy
on the wind S.E. and latter moderate
saw several sail on the wind to the N.E.
Lat 40.03 Long 31.29
