at 6 AM made S. de Cunha bearing W by N 40 N distant
saw a right whale heading for the land. found
my chronometer 40 hrs to the Lat 37.9 Long 10.3
Saturday

Comd. fresh gales N.W. covered S by S. at 7 took
fly jib & jib top. latter strong gales S.W.

Saturday Jan 9th
Comd. strong gales S.W. steering E by S. mid latter as

Sunday Jan 10th
Comd. light breeze W. steering E by S. mid latter
the same Lat 35.38 Long 20.10

Monday Jan 11th
Comd. fresh gales N.W. covered S.W. at 3 PM raised a
school of sperm whale. Jones & Strickland one to the S.W.
she took the lead mid & latter mid no. Lat 35.37 Long 25.56
Tuesday Jan 12th

Comd. strong gales W. steering E by S. mid foggy latter
light air & variable saw a sail to the E. Lat 35.39 Long 34.49
Wednesday Jan 13th

First part light winds N.E. the sail in sight was
S. latter as seen on Eng ship bound E. Lat 35.25 Long 52.18
Thursday Jan 14th

Comd. light breeze from N.W. steering S.W. by E & E.
latter strong gales S.W. on the 12. S.W. by E Lat 35.20
Friday Jan 15th

Comd. strong gales from S.W. steering E by S. latter
about the same Lat 35.27
Saturday Jan 16th

Comd. with strong gales S.W. by E. mid & latter
the same So ends Lat 33.12 Long 11.32

Sunday Jan 7th 1841

Comd. light breeze S.W. on the wind S.W.
mid & latter the same Lat 33.25 Long 13.9 Chro 13.14
Monday Jan 18th

Comd. fresh gales S.W. on the wind S.W. by E. latter
tacked to N.W. Lat 33.12 Long 15.46 Chro 12.22
Tuesday 19 Jan

Comd. strong gales S on the 12. N.W. by S. took in
jib & Sparker hauled. maintail mid & latter the
same one boatsteerer Pick Lat 34.18

Wednesday Jan 20th
Comd. the same mid & latter do. Lat 34.47 Long 10.34
Thursday Jan 21st

First part moderate set in top & sail mid & latter
light winds tacked to the N.W. Lat 34.40 Long 11.15
Friday Jan 22nd

Comd. light breeze S on the wind N.W. saw a sail
bound to the E. latter light breeze N.W. tacked to S. Lat 35.3
Saturday Jan 23rd

Comd. light & variable air steering S.W. by S. saw a
sail bent a new jib repaired S.W. by S. mid & latter
strong breeze & rain N.W. Lat 35.50 Long 11.50
Sunday Jan 24th

Comd. strong gales from S.W. covered S.W. by S. put 2
masts into the rigging and gave them a screw each
for disobeying orders latter strong gales from N.W.
Lat 36.41 Long 14.10

Monday Jan 25th
Comd. strong gales from N.W. to W.S.W. with some
rain covered S.W. low boat turned up latter moderate
all sail out Lat 37.30 Long 18.34
Tuesday Jan 26th

Comd. moderate gales N.W. latter N. No Obs
Wednesday Jan 27th

Comd. light breeze from N.W. saw a great
many B. fish bound the boat and not further Lat 37.56
latter strong gales with squalls from N.W. Chro 23.40
