Saturday 22nd May 1841

Comd. fresh breeze ESE on the wind N.E. Mica
& latter the same Lat 17.11 Long 115.54

Sunday May 23rd

Comd. fresh gales ESE Mica & latter about the same Lat 15.32 Long 117.35

Monday May 24th

Comd. fresh gales ESE on the wind N.E. cruising for
Sperm whales Mica & latter about the same employed in
caulking decks Lat 14.16 Long 118.43

Tuesday May 25th

Comd. light breeze ESE caulking decks Mica & latter
about the same Lat 12.34 Long 119.30 two men off duty

Wednesday May 26th

Comd. fresh gales ESE employed in caulking Mica &
latter as before Lat 11.02 Long 120.00 Obs. 119.19

Thursday May 27th

Comd. fresh gales ESE caulking decks saw many Sperm
whales Mica tacked to the S. at 3 A.M. tacked again
at 9 A.M. Mica Sanaalnooa Is. bear N. 30 M. Lat 10.00

Friday May 28th

Comd. fresh gales ESE at 4 M. within 6 M. of the land
tacked to the S. saw first Mica & latter as before Lat 10.55 Long 117.15

Saturday May 29th

Comd. fresh gales ESE on the wind N.E. Mica & latter
the same tacking to get Lat 14.17 Long 118.32

Sunday May 30th

Comd. fresh gales ESE at 4 M. tacked to N. Mica
& latter about the same Lat 13.32 Long 118.48

Monday May 31st

First part moderate gales ESE tacked to S. Mica
& latter the same Lat 11.27 Long 119.2

Tuesday June 1st

First part. light breeze ESE on the wind to S.
Mica & latter as before Lat 15.40 Long 119.48

Wednesday June 2nd

First part light breeze ESE standing to Mica
light and fresh latter light breeze N.E. Lat 16.13 Long 119.49

Bark Fortune in the Timor Straits

Thursday June 3rd 1841

Comd. light breeze N.E. on the wind ESE sun glare
Mica & latter light & variable winds sun glare
snakes & quails landed &c. Lat 16.3 Long 120.37

Friday June 4th 1841

First part light & variable winds Mica calm latter
light air Lat 15.59 Long 119.39

Saturday June 5th

First part light air & calm Mica & latter do. turned
out J. Williams boatw. and put in J.P. Libbey

Lat 15.46 Long 120.42

Sunday June 6th

First part calm latter light breeze ESE Lat 15.22 Long 120.5

Monday June 7th

First part light breeze ESE sun first two men off
duty with sickness latter wind the same Lat 14.15 Long 120.54

Tuesday June 8th

Comd. light winds ESE at 2 P.M. made Scotts Reef
bearing N.E. 15 M. Mica wind N.E. by E. tacked to S.E. & sailed
at 12 M. at 8 M. 2 boats went fishing saw 2 Porpoises
and a number of Maylays collecting beachcombs Lat 13.18

Wednesday June 9th

Comd. light breeze ESE on the wind N. Mica & latter
about the same Lat 12.57 Long 121.10

Thursday June 10th

Comd. light breeze ESE N. killed blackfish saw finches
&c. latter fresh gales picked up 50 Antelopes Lat 12.2 Long 121.44

Friday June 11th

Comd. fresh gales from ESE coast N.E. bound into
Cape Agassiz daylight made the Is. of Rott bearing N.E.
25 M. at 10 M. calm Lat 10.53 Long 121.55 out to 12

Saturday June 12th

At 2 P.M. light breeze S.E. on the wind N.E. by E. found
strong current setting to Vanarow at sunset the N.W.
point of Rott bore S.E. daylight made Timor at 10 M.
& point bore E by N 8 M. Lat 10.12
