

Barke Tortured in the North Pacific Ocean
Wednesday Sept. 1st

First part light & variable winds bound E. from
the current setting to S.W. mid & later about
the same Lat by Oct. 7.00 Long 141.45

Thursday Sept 2nd

First part raised a school of sperm whales bound
took one to the S. B. and five to the S. B. later
cut in our whales Lat 1.30 Long 142.46

Friday Sept 3rd

First part light rain squalls come boiling down
a large break & night mid & later boiling some rain
Lat 1.54 Long 145.17

Saturday Sept 4th

First part light winds & rainy finished boiling
mid & later squally with rain Lat 1.39 N.

Sunday Sept 5th

First part light breeze & squally mid & later
about the same Lat 1.18 N. Long 144.96

Monday Sept 6th

First part light & variable winds mid & later mid
SE Lat 2.20 Long 144.57

Tuesday Sept 7th

First part light breeze ESE on the wind NE mid
& later SE. repaying sails Lat 2.27 Long 145.21

Wednesday Sept 8th

First part light & variable with squalls of rain saw
whales but did not ascertain what they were later
rainy No Lat

Thursday Sept 9th

First rainy. mid & later squalls of rain Lat 2.33 Long 145.37

Friday Sept 10th

Could light winds & squalls of rain mid & later
much the same No Obs.

Saturday Sept 10th

First part light & variable winds and squally mid
later rainy No Obs. moved to the S. B. none of
the time & current to the S. at present No Obs
taken etc

Barke Tortured in the North Pacific Ocean
Sunday Sept 12th 1841

First part fresh gales ESE & cloudy on the
wind to NW. mid & later about the same No Obs.


Monday Sept 13th

Could light breeze NW & rainy course SE. later
wind SE. stored away our oil Lat 2.54 Long 146

Tuesday Sept 14th

First part light breeze SE on the wind E. No
Scott no later. mid & later much the same Lat 3.18 Long 147

Wednesday Sept 15th

First part light breeze SE. later the same covered
& took 3 whales to the S. B. 

Thursday Sept 16th

First part breeze cut our whales later come boiling
Lat 2.42 N. Long 147.39

Friday Sept 17th

Fresh breeze ESE & squally could rufed the top. sail
mid & later boiling Lat 3.30 Long 148.

Saturday Sept 18th

First part light breeze NW & cooled down
later light breeze NW. mid SE Lat 3.39 Long 149.2

Sunday Sept 19th

First part light and calm later squally & some rain
Monday Sept 20th

First part light breeze SW. later squally storing away
Tuesday Sept 21st Lat 1.8 Long 149.2

Wednesday Sept 22nd

First part light breeze SW. course SSE. mid & later
rainy No Obs.

Thursday Sept 23rd

First part squally with rain mid & later strong gale
Friday Sept 24th

First part strong gales SEW & PM. made
Leaving 2.20 PM. later strong gales & rainy
Lat 1.50 S. Long 150.10
