Monday April 18th

First part fine weather all hands on liberty at
dinner all on board. Later showed the Oil Co.

Tuesday April 19th

First part broke out the fore peak to stop also
cut off one of the porters & 2 timbers but did not
stop it mid. the same later found the bark
Ship Rochester arrived. 20 PM. 1400 hrs

Wednesday April 20th

Joining of water & stone ballast &c. later trying to
stop the leak &c. &c.

Thursday April 21st

Putting water stone ballast stopping leak &c.
later about the same

Friday April 22nd

Joining water & stone ballast &c. later the same

Saturday April 23rd

Joining water &c. later put W. Langley in the
rigging & removed him for measuring to stab the
shell &c.

Sunday April 24th

Got off our last raft & stowed it. later took the anchor

Monday April 25th

At 5 PM came to anchor in the harbour for painting
Ship mending &c. later mending painting &c.

Tuesday April 26th

Painting Ship mending &c. later the same

Wednesday April 27th

Painting mending &c. some rain later do 1 watch

Thursday April 28th

Mending painting &c. one watch on liberty Mm
& catch the same. Emerals left for Japan.

Friday April 29th

First part some rain & fresh gales &c.
watch on liberty later one man assisted with
watch on board

First part 2 watch on liberty Mm & later the
same. Abigail & St. George sailed.

Sunday May 1st

First part 2 watch on liberty the other employ-
ed in ship's duty. later much the same.

Monday May 2nd

Fresh gales & some rain later all hands on
board

Tuesday May 3rd

First part fresh gales & rainy all hands on
board Mm & later the same

Wednesday May 4th

Good fresh gales & rainy all hands on board
Mm the same later sent down top gate &c.

Thursday May 5th

Blowing heavy with much rain Mm &
later the same. Ship arriving, both anchored ahead

Friday May 6th

Gale about the same, Rochester & Agabon &c.
later more moderate but rainy

Saturday May 7th

Light rain & much rain heavy much heavy
in to the harbour later some rain

Sunday May 8th

Fresh gales &c. one watch on liberty Rochester
took their anchor later about the same

Monday May 9th

Fresh gales one watch on liberty Mm
& later the same

Tuesday May 10th

Light breeze & fine all hands on board
came up top gate masts &c. 20 PM took the anchor
& stood to the N. bound for Japan with a light
breeze &c.

Wednesday May 11th

Light breeze &c. Mm & later the same
first part B. B. B.
