Comd. light and E.S.E. course N.W. by N. paint

Light breeze S.W. latter rain course N.W.
Friday 5th Lat 27.55.62.47

Monday July 8th
Fresh gales S.W. by W. & squalls of rain course
N.W. latter light winds & rainy Lat 33.10 Long 67.35

Tuesday July 9 1844
Light variable winds & calm Mull & latter calm
saw 2 sail (menacing sails) Vals

Wednesday July 10
Light breeze S.W. latter W.S.W. & rainy
took in royals & top g't studs saw a schooner
& ship & some weed Lat 34.8 Long 67.38

Thursday July 11
Fresh gales S.W. by W. & squalls of rain
parted the ship to the foreward course N.W.
Mull & latter much the same Lat 35.26.69.10

Friday July 12
Strong gales from W.S.W. to N.W. & squalls
of rain Mull & latter do Lat 36.58 Long 69.34

some weed Saturday July 13
Light winds N. on the wind & fresh the fore
saw 2 sail Mull & latter to W. latter fresh gales
& plenty weed Lat 36.58.70.9

Sunday July 14
Comd. light winds N. heading W. & W. saw
a Bark bound E.S. Mull & latter light and
& calm some weed Lat 37.9 Long 70.5

In the Monday July 15 full moon
Light and W.S.W. latter N.W. saw 2 sail
Mull & latter fresh gales & some lightning
& to some weed Lat 38.30.70.61

Tuesday 16th
Commodore light breeze W.S.W. course N.
Mull & latter fresh gales S.W. steering N.
spoke Bark Harriet Duffer from Freetown
bound for N.W. saw a schooner Lat 39.39.70.28

Wednesday 17th
Fresh gales S.W. & rainy saw a Bark bound
to N.W. & 6:15 Thunder lightning rain &c

Shortened sail & rounded & got 40 fathom
saw the Bottom mid & latter light and & calm & sail
in sight 2 1/2 AM rounded 40 f. saw parted & lost the ship
see last Lat 40.25. Long 72.10
