Remarks on Tuesday Oct 7th

First and middle part light from East and pleasant weather Ste S.E. at 6 AM wind shifted to S.E. Saw one Fin back Go Ends watch variously employed about the Ship

Remarks on Wednesday Oct 8th Long 152:25 Lat 26:58

These 24 hours light airs from South and calm watch variously employed about the Ship Go Ends nothing in sight Lat 26:40

Remarks on Thursday Oct 9th Long 152:39

This Day light baffling airs and calm watch employed in drying and bundling. None Go Ends Moss no better Lat by Obs 26:21

Remarks on Friday Oct 10th

All this Day calm and fine pleasant weather employed in drying and bundling. None at 6 PM saw school of Black fish lead by B. Winst. Boats for them did get any invalids improving Go Ends Lat by Obs 26:15

Remarks on Saturday Oct 11th Long by Obs 152:54

These 24 hours light baffling airs and calm Ste South watch employed in Ship's duty at 10 AM raised a sail eastern Go Ends Moss no better Lat 25:50

Remarks on Sunday Oct 12th Long 153:00

This Day took the trades and Ste South and light showers at 4 PM spoke the Levi Starbuck with 500 lbs of Oil saw another sail to seaward Go Ends Lat 24:12 Long 153:23

Remarks on Monday Oct 13th

Day with moderate breezes from East and flying squalls Ste South two sail in sight latter strong trades and heavy watch employed in getting out water, Go Ends Carpenter below sick Moss no better Lat by Obs 22:3 Long by Obs 154:00

Remarks on Tuesday Oct 14th

These 24 hours strong trades and cloudy weather Ste South with all sail out one sail in sight at 7 AM saw the last point of Owyhee bearing S by W dist 30 miles we stood off S by E in the Trades at noon lopped to outside of the bar for Pilot at 10 AM bent chains got the anchors off the Bows & put up the sail poles

Remarks on Wednesday Oct 15th

Light airs and pleasant weather at 1 PM got a Pilot and went into the harbor 3 PM came to in 5 tons of water with best bower Capt went ashore later employed in painting Ship Ste watch on liberty invalids no better

Remarks on Thursday Oct 16th

Time pleasant weather with light Trades Larboard watch then on liberty got off wreck of weather hoisted it in heeled the Ship Blacked the Bends Carpenter some better Moss no better

Remarks on Friday Oct 17th

Cloudy weather and light Trades of rain with fresh sea breezes Ste watch on liberty. The other to work breaking out in ground tier pumping fresh water out and filling salt water the Columbus of Santacks came in it rained very hard through the night

Remarks on Saturday Oct 18th

This Day cloudy unsettled weather to work breakout and stowing fresh water we got the Black Smith & Levi Starbuck to come aboard and fit our windlass Larboard watch on liberty Go Ends Moss some better

Remarks on Sunday Oct 19th

Time pleasant weather Ste watch on liberty. The Ship Seine & Barque Stogly came in Go Ends

Remarks on Monday Oct 20th

This Day dark cloudy weather stowing away and getting off water Ste watch on liberty Moss & Carpenter some better Go Ends

Remarks on Tuesday Oct 21th

Pleasant weather and light Trades watch employed in stowing away water, breaking out between Decks Ste watch on liberty

Remarks on Wednesday Oct 22nd

Time pleasant weather employed in getting off recruits Potatoes pumpkins & Mannanas we put on some 60 bundles on board of Copia for home it weighed 8000 lbs. Larboard watch on liberty sundown they all came off but Brown and he deserted Go Ends

Remarks on Thursday Oct 23rd

This Day light breezes from S.E. and fine weather all hands employed in getting ready for sea at daylight Second Mate went on board of Copia to stow the home at 7 AM came aboard 10 Pilot came off half past 11, have short and got under way stood out of the Harbour Capt & Boats crew on shore at noon Pilot left us one mile and a half out side of the Reef Go Ends
