

Barque Fortune of New Bedford Capt Davis

Remarks for Tuesday Feb 8th

Lying in port of Valparaiso with fine weather and light winds employed in breaking down oil getting it ready to raft Latter part rafted 21 casks of Oil oil had sent it ashore safe

Remarks for Wednesday Feb 9th

Lying in port of Valparaiso with fine weather and light winds employed in breaking out the Main Hatch and showing it again took on board 4 casks and two boxes of Iron head matter from shore Latter part breaking out in the Main Hatch and coopersing and stowing down again

Remarks for Thursday Feb 10th

Lying in port of Valparaiso all hands employed breaking out oil and coopersing it and stowing the ground tier in

The Main Hatch Latter part sent a raft of 28 Casks of Whale Oil ashore and breaking out more

Remarks for Friday Feb 11th

Lying in port of Valparaiso with strong breeze employed in breaking out oil and getting up the bone Latter part sent a raft of 31 Casks ashore and commenced weighing the bone to send home

Remarks for Saturday Feb 12th

Lying in port of Valparaiso with light breeze of shore employed in weighing the bone and sent it On Board of Ship Greyhound of Baltimore MD

To go to Boston Latter part stowing down Got 5 bbls of Meat from the Greyhound and four from the shore Bone weighed 10,588 lbs Sold one boat returned

Remarks for Sunday Feb 13th

Lying in port of Valparaiso with light winds Finished stowing down the oil that was on deck and clearing up decks Coopers and two Boatstainers and one man forward on liberty Latter part washed up decks and sent the Landward Water to go ashore on liberty

Lying at Anchor in Valparaiso. A.D. 1853.

Remarks for Monday Feb 14th

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Commenced with Lying in port of Valparaiso with strong Breeze of shore nothing doing aboard ship stevedore party Latter part broke out water one Boatstainer and Williams Garvey and Thorne did not come aboard

Remarks for Tuesday Feb 15th

Lying in the port of Valparaiso with light air employed in breaking out the after hatch took on board 50 bbls Meat 60 bags Bread 10 Sacks Flour 7 water casks and 7 Oil Casks stowed down the meat also some small stores 1 bbl Rice 1 bag Apples 1 bag Beans

Latter part finished stowing the Meat and started some bread out of the bags into casks

Remarks for Wednesday Feb 16th

Lying in the port of Valparaiso with good weather employed in stowing water casks and getting ready to take in water 1 man got ashore at dinner time and did not come of again received 7 water casks from shore Latter part water tank alongside took on board 234 bbls water got up and 2 casks from shore

Remarks for Thursday Feb 17th

Lying in the Port of Valparaiso good weather all hands employed in stowing bread and clearing up decks Latter part scraping ship and painting

Remarks for Friday Feb 18th

Lying in port of Valparaiso with good weather and light winds took on board 54 Sacks potatoes some Cabbage and Onions Latter part finished scraping painting some on the Starboard side

Remarks for Saturday Feb 19th

Lying in the port of Valparaiso with good weather and light winds employed in hoisting Main Top Sail and getting ready for Sea took on board 11 water casks Latter part took on board 7 water casks and 129 bbls Water started some bread and the rest of the casks Flour into casks
