Remarks for Sunday Feb 20

Lying in port of Valparaiso with good weather
8 employes stowing water took 2 men on shore
To ship them one of them M. J. on all deserted
Before shipping discharge Hamilton and
Marianna Boatman. Day deserted from the ship
T. men that the Capt. Shipper came off
Latter part of the day came off and the rest of the
men that the Capt. Shipper came off and
had headed the ship to go to sea this afternoon

Remarks for Monday Feb 21st

Lying in port of Valparaiso with light breeze
At 2 o'clock Capt. came aboard here up the anchor
and stood out to sea strong breeze out side from
Land S. by E. steering by the wind Larboard tack aloft
With whole top sails and courses
Latter part of the day the top sails strong
Breeze and hazy weather got the anchors on the
lines lashed them

Remarks for Tuesday Feb 22nd

Commenced with strong breeze from the S. E.
Heaving S. W. and S. W. by W. with double reefed top sails
and courses & set out the lower boat of the

Traverse but did not do any damage

Latter part more moderate shook the reefs out of
the top sails stowing of and on the land

Remarks for Wednesday Feb 23rd

Commenced with moderate breeze from the S. and E.
Heaving on and off the land Valparaiso Light house in
sight Latter part lying off the Harbor of Valparaiso
Shore boat came off in the Capt. went on shore to
hunt up deserters lying on and off with light
baffling winds

Remarks for Thursday Feb 24th

Commenced with light baffling winds lying on and
off Valparaiso 5 o'clock Capt. came off bringing two men
that deserted Jay and Williams. Calm
Middle and Latter part wind S. E. Steaming N. by E.
Employes lashing the anchors and setting up rigging

Remarks for Friday Feb 25th

Commenced with calm water employes washing the
outside and setting up rigging 1 Sail in sight
Middle and Latter part light air from the S. E. Steaming
N. by W. employes in ordinary ships duty 1 Sail in
sight saw one school of small black fish

Remarks for Saturday Feb 26th

Commenced with calm water employes setting up
rigging and other ships duty 1 Sail in sight
Middle and Latter part calm water employes in
ordinary ships duty Bab, Williams, the Carpenter and
Manuel, Ortega of duty sick

Remarks for Sunday Feb 27th

Commenced with light breeze from the S. W.
Steaming N. by W. with all sail set water
Employes about the ship in different jobs
Middle part wind S. W. Latter part wind S. E.
Steaming N. by W. with all sail set in ship duty
Invalids much the same all sail set

Remarks for Monday Feb 28th

Commenced with moderate breeze from the S. E.
Steaming N. by W. with all sail out and cloudy weather
Water employes in ordinary ships duty
Middle and Latter part moderate breeze from the S. E.
Steaming N. by W. with all sail out water employes breaking
out fore hold for Shanks Williams on duty the others much
the same
