Commenced with light breeze from the S.E. Steering N.W. all sail out water employed in ship's duty some light rain squalls Middle and Latter part wind S. Steering N.W. all sail out with frequent rain squalls - not much going or bringing. Invalids remain about the same

Remarks for Monday Mar 21st

Commenced with moderate breeze from S.E. and cloudy weather with rain Steering N.W. Watch employed in ordinary ship's duty Middle and Latter part wind N.E. Steering N.W. clear

Water watch employed washing ship inside. Sail in sight. Invalids much the same

Remarks for Tuesday Mar 22nd

Commenced with light breeze from the S.E. and good weather Steering N.W. all sail set water employed Breaking out after hatch for clear time and clearing one hatch in sight Middle part raining wind S.E. Latter part clear weather wind S.E. Steering N.W. 2 sail in sight invalids getting better Watch employed in ordinary ship's duty

Commenced with moderate breeze from S.E. and good weather Steering N.W. all sail out water employed setting up main top mast rigging and Breaking out for meat saw some sprouts but going to quick to see what they was Middle and Latter part much the same water employed Taking out the Leeward port and setting a new one Invalids much the same

Commenced with light air from S. to N.E. Steering N.W. all sail out and good weather water employed in doing small jobs about the ship Middle and Latter part light air Steering N.W. water employed in ship's duty

Commenced with light breeze from the S.E. and good weather Steering N.W. all sail out water employed Breaking out main hatch for water Middle and Latter part wind S.E. Steering N.W. 2 sail in sight Breaking out Main hatch and other small jobs invalids better One sail in sight
