

Barge Fortune of New Bedford Capt Davis

Remarks for Saturday August 27th

Commenced with moderate breeze from North and West Lying at Anchor employed hauling 3 boats of whaling 5 for Starboard Boat came aboard without success 7 for West boat struck once X Whale and anchored him bow boat struck and Laid by the X Middle part much the same latter part started the Works again sent the waist boat up to bow boat to anchor the whale the rest employed stowing down in After held four 8 casks down there Partially lashed Out took them up started them and wrapped them And stowed them again Manual Tools of day sick

Remarks for Sunday August 28th

Commenced with strong breeze from North and West Lying at Anchor Employed hauling and stowing down in after held West boat of whaling 8 for Starboard and bow boats And went to help tow the waist boats whale got to side 8 for got him alongside Middle part hauling latter part Hauled down and commenced cutting 9 am finished cutting and sent 2 boats of it to get the bow boat whale the rest got ship Underweigh and dropped down for the whale

Remarks for Monday August 29th

Commenced with calm found the whale and came to again sent the other boats of to help tow 5 for got him alongside And commenced cutting 8 for finished cutting Middle part Cutting up blubber and clearing up decks latter part Started the works West or bow boats of whaling employed Hauling and stowing down

Remarks for Tuesday August 30th

Commenced with calm Lying at Anchor West and bow boats of Whaling Bow boat missed 7 for boat came aboard without success Middle hauling latter light breeze from West Laid 3 boats Starboard boat struck and whale sunk got unloosed and X Went to the whale anchored him and came aboard Came to again in 14 fathoms water calm sun more ship Stowing of before the wind

Lying at Anchor in Chatham Sea Aug^r 1853

Remarks for Wednesday August 31st

Commenced with calm Lying at Anchor employed hauling and Stowing down 2 boats of whaling West boat struck and whale X Drove came aboard 6 for bow boat came aboard without success Middle part could clear and started some water into the Boats latter part hauled the Starboard boat whale up And took him alongside commenced cutting 11 am finished Cutting got underweigh and went to the West boat whale Could not haul him came to again

Remarks for Thursday Sept 1st

Commenced with light breeze from North Lying at Anchor Employed Breaking out fimsy Shacks and hauling latter part hauled 2 boats and hauled the waist boats whale up and commenced Cutting could down Cooper setting up Shacks

Remarks for Friday Sept 2^d

Commenced with calm Lying at Anchor Employed cutting 8 for finished cutting broke out fore hold for fimsy Shacks And cutt up the blubber started the works Middle part Hauling calm 8 ships in sight latter part employed hauling Stowing down and setting up Shacks Laid Starboard boat And went of whaling

Remarks for Saturday Sept 3^d

Commenced with calm Lying at Anchor Laid Starboard boat off whaling the rest employed hauling stowing down and setting up Shacks 3 for Starboard boat came aboard without success Middle part employed hauling latter part light breeze from East West and bow boat of whaling the rest Employed hauling up Shacks and stowing down in fore hold

Remarks for Sunday Sept 4th

Commenced with light breeze from South and East Lying at Anchor this part bow boats of whaling the rest employed hauling stowing down and setting up Shacks 5 for bow boats Came aboard without success Middle part hauling latter part strong breeze from S.E. and N.W. with Rain could clear and secured the things about Deck 11 am more moderate cleared up
