Remarks for Friday Sept 23^d

Commenced with light breeze from North and East^d lying at anchor commenced cutting 5 pm finished cutting Middle part cutting up the bladder started the works Latter part employed boiling got underweigh and stood out the ship with light breeze from South^d & towing down in after hold and clearing up decks invalids no better

Remarks for Saturday Sept 24th

Commenced with light breeze from S.W. lying at anchor employed boiling saw the barge in Lanchester 3 pm saw Whets Lanchester Lanchester and West boats without success Middle part wind from S.W. towing N.W. Latter part employed boiling and setting up sheets light breeze from South and East invalids much the same

Remarks for Sunday Sept 25th

Commenced with light breeze from S.W. starting by the wind employed boiling saw whets Lanchester and West boats West boat struck 7 pm took him along side and came to in 21 fathoms water Lanchester anchor ahead Middle part wind shifted to N.W. and blowed very hard could down Latter part moderate down with rain and snow 11 am quite smooth started the works again pleasant invalids no better

Remarks for Monday Sept 26th

Commenced with light breeze from West^d lying at anchor employed boiling and cutting 6 pm finished cutting and coaled down Middle part strong breeze from North^d 3 am got underweigh to make a lee wind hauled to N.W. ran into with gorse bag so called and came to again in 8 fathoms water both boats ahead 10 am wind hauled to North again 11 am more moderate invalids much the same

Remarks for Tuesday Sept 27th

Commenced with strong breeze from North^d lying at anchor both anchors ahead employed securing cables on deck Middle part moderate down calm started the works Latter part calm bore up Lanchester and anchor employed towing down in fore hold invalids about the same

Remarks for Wednesday Sept 28th

Commenced with light breeze from North and West^d lying at anchor Lanchester and anchor ahead employed boiling towing down in fore hold and setting up sheets Middle part boiling Latter part wind much the same good weather employed boiling and towing down invalids much the same

Remarks for Thursday Sept 29th

Commenced with light breeze from N.W. lying at anchor employed boiling towing down and setting up sheets Middle part calm boiling Latter part coaled down Light breeze from N.W. employed towing down invalids no better

Remarks for Friday Sept 30th

Commenced with light breeze from N.W. lying at anchor employed towing down pipes in Main Hatch Middle part strong breeze from North^d and rain Latter part wind hauled to N.W. with drizzling rain employed towing down pipes finished main hatch invalids no better Mower very bad

Remarks for Saturday Oct 1st

Commenced with strong breeze from N.W. lying at anchor Lanchester and anchor ahead and let go starboard anchor employed towing pipes finished Middle part strong Gale from North^d with heavy rain Latter part more moderate finished towing down closed up decks Mower Mark the same Adams Rundelph and Peter of duty sick Mate Sick of duty

Remarks for Sunday Oct 2^d

Commenced with strong breeze from N.W. with foggy rainy weather lying at anchor both anchors ahead employed cleaning up decks getting ready for sea Middle part more moderate Latter part strong breeze from N.W. got underweigh and stood out of the bay heading N.W. 10 am wind hauled to East^d hauling up N.W. took in Bow Boat and hauled it on the house invalids much the same
