heading S.W. by S. and S.W. all sail out and good
Weather watch employed in ship duty 5 pm taken
Ship heading East and S.W. Middle and Latter
part wind South and West heading S.W. by S. and S.W.
Adams about the same

Remarks for Wednesday Jan 25th

Commenced with light breeze from South and West
blowing S.W. by S with all sail out and cloudy heavy
Weather watch variously employed 6 pm more ship heading
East and S.W. by N light air in Middle part more ship heading
S.W. Latter part calm sent down F.T.G. sail to repair

Remarks for Thursday Jan 26th

Commenced with calm watch employed repairing
F.T.G. sail and lost it 2 pm light air more ship
heading East and S.W. 6 pm light baffling air more ship
heading S.W. Middle and Latter part light baffling
Wind Adams much the same

Ship duty 6 pm Calm Middle part light breeze from N.W.
blowing S.W. Latter part wind N. One sail in sight
Adams much the same

Long by Obs 159-55

With all sail out and good weather watch employed in
Ship duty Middle part much the same Latter part
