Set standing sails and kept of W. & E. 10 am kept of W. & E.
General sail in sight Lat 41° 8' 16"
Long 71° 34' 49"

Remarks for Monday Apr 10th

Commenced with strong breeze from S.E. standing N.W. & E.
With all sail out for Pernambuco 3 for saw the land
Bearing N. distance 9 Leagues 5 for saw the City of Chinola
And Pernambuco 4 sail in sight 6 for saw the light
Bearing N.W. & E. luffed up on the wind & stood on
Middle part lying of and on Pernambuco latter part
Capt went ashore 10 for boat came aboard and took the
Water casks ashore Saw the Ship Cirimole of New Bedford
Lying of and on

Remarks for Tuesday Apr 11th

Commenced with strong breeze from S.E. lying of and on
Pernambuco Capt ashore at sunset then 10 for
Started to come off could not hit the ship and
Went aboard of a Black Brig and stayed all night
Ran along side in the morning with boat stove
1 for Second Mate went ashore after the Capt. ran
Launch came off with the wave and water and some
Changes soon after the ship struck on the bottom
Slightly did no damage

Commenced with strong breeze from S.E. lying of and on
Pernambuco 2 for Capt. came aboard kept of N.W. & E.
And set standing sails Middle part strong breeze standing
N.W. & E. Latter part standing N.W. & E. and sailing 11 am luffed up
From S. took in standing sails put out the bow boat and the
Starboard cranes
