 a large reception from her Capt and Officers
 at 4 PM the boat returned and started for
 Washington Island
 Nov 22 made the the Land found it to be a
 small Island covered with wood with a great surf
 breaking so that we could not land Nov 23 Lay
 off and on Monday the 24 started to the Northward
 and left the Land without view Lat 5 2 North
 Long 160 3 W
 December the 9 long the Line in Long 159 58 W
 Dec 12 saw a school of whale and got 4 in
 Lat 2 20 South Long 150 19
 Dec 26 and 27 saw a great many whale got 2 and
 cut them in

Dec 30 saw whale and got 5 at noon Jan 1
 Drayton St Parker with no Lat 152 S Long 160 20 W
 January 1 1844 saw a school of whale going quick
 to the northward Lat 2 0 S Long 160 W

 recovered the Line and started for Fanning Island
 having no view on shore
 January 21 saw the Island the 22 23 and 24 employed

 Jan 26 saw a large whale struck it but found it
 on the decline covered the sun Lat 2 10 S Long
 February the 6 saw a school of whale got one Lat 2 20 S
 Long 162 45 W
 February 13 the crossed the Line to the Northward
 February 16 saw Fanning Island bearing N by E 15 miles
 distance started in for the Land spoke with the
 Falcon laying off and on for wood and water
 the ship Lyons of New Bedford in the harbour
 capturing her oil
 Feb 17 equally the 18 started to the Northward
 for the Sandwich Islands
 March the 7 saw the Land bearing N by E 40
 40 miles dist the 8 and 9 light breeze and the
 is anchored of the harbour at the Island of
 Washoe on the 11 light wind at West
 took the anchor and ran into the harbour
