Friday 22 strong gales from the S.W. at 2 PM
came an American whaler ship with a broad wing
yellow awnings and went down on deck at 2 PM
with strong breeze Lat 43 18 Long 51.47

Saturday 23 light breeze and calm from the
Eastward. Lat 43 45 Long 52.10

Sunday 24 strong gales from the S.W. towards
Leeward to the Northward. Lat 43 50 Long 53.00

Monday 25 continued with strong gale from the
N.E. Lat 44 00 Long 54.00

Tuesday 26 first part light wind Lat 44 00
strong gale from the East in evening
Lat 44 00 Long by Lunar 55.30

Wednesday 27 moderate gale at Leeward towards the
Lat 44 17 Long 56.42

from the 20 to the 1st of November had strong breeze
from S.E. to S.W. started from Oct 5 to 25
at 11 PM spoke the ship Antonio of Montevideo
with 2000 fms west D 23.00 Long 57.20

November 2 spoke the large barque for Rio
de Janeiro a French one the name spoke D Long
Lat 44 16 Long 58.20

November 3 the wind veered more to the Northward
spoke the ship and started to the eastward
in the 2 PM the Lat 44 22 Long 59.40

from Oct 9 to the 20 the wind moderated to the
Northward employed in fishing to the Northward

November 4 in Lat 44 34 Long 60.00 wind veered
to the Eastward more all sail and started at 1 PM
November 5 strong breeze from S.E. towards the N.W.

Lat 44 40 Long 61.30
November 6 fresh breeze and clear. Course N by W

Lat 44 50 Long 62.10
November 7 gentle breeze from S.E. towards N.W.

found a strong current setting to the Northward
Lat 45 00 Long 63.11
November 8 wind at North much the same as
before N by W Lat 45 10 Long by Lunar 64.00

November 9 the 22nd as gentle breeze from S.E. to
S.W. with more light squalls of rain Lat 45 20 Long 65.00

November 10 wind at N.E. blowing strong
Course N by W Lat 45 26 Long by Lunar 66.00
