March 11th 1891
Calms and light airs from
all ways steering to the N
N.W. when possible. Hawaii
& "Momi" in sight.

March 12th
Light airs from N.W. steering
by the wind on the S. part.
The Islands all in sight.

Lat - 21.38
Long 156.04

March 13th
Took the N.E. trades today
and went down through
between "Molokai" & "Momi"
sighted "Oahu" at dark.

March 14th
Strong trades at daylight -
went right off "Diamond
Head" right whales lying
off and on, went ashore
at 10 A.M. and delivered
vessel over to Capt. D. F. Devoll
for the northern cruise

March 14 to 19th
Lying off and on all but
36 hours when we anchored
and discharged 36 bbls of sperm
oil and took on board 192
bbls of water and some coal
and provisions

Bound to "Oahu" & Arctic Ocean 1891
March 20th

Sailed from "Oahu" today at
4 P.M. for the Arctic ocean.
Strong N.E. trades, storm
anchors and chains and choosed
patches and boats crews.

March 21st
Strong N.E. trades steering N.N.W. with
nothing of note occurring.

March 22nd
Strong N.E. trades steering N.N.W.

March 23rd
Strong N.E. trades with squalls
steering N.N.W. Ben away old gib.
broke out - new one and went it -

March 24th
Moderate trades went new
topsails & fly gib. Broke out -
water & meat

March 25th
Moderate N.E. trades steering
gull and by on the track
opened slop east and gave
out clothing also repairing
fly gib.

March 26th
Moderate N.E. trades steering the
same, turned over waist and
L. Boats and lashed them to the
davit-heads, also at work
putting new rope on fly gib.

March 27th
Calms & light airs from all
directions steering N by W. when
possible, variously employed
in ship's duty.
