Strong breeze from N.N.W.
Steering E by S. a sail in
sight ahead.

Strong N.N.W. breeze.
Steering East. scraped "masts"
and "Main Boom"

Moderate breezes from the West.
S.W. and around to the S.S.E.
at dark. washed our two heads
of "Bone" today and partly dried it

Oct 29th

Light breezes from the S.W. & South.
Steering East. some rain.

Lat. 42.09
Long. 141.48
Oct 30th

Calm and light variable winds
with some rain squalls.
Steering East when possible
washed paint-work today.

Lat. 41.57
Long. 140.09
Oct 31st

Blowing heavy from the South. with
frequent squalls and heavy rain.
Steering East. under easy sail

with much rain and squalls.
