winds from N.W. at 7 A.M. changed
course to S. crew employed in
rigging the boats and clearing
decks. S. 30 steering S.E. wind slight
36 - 38 N
123 - 47 W

Nov 26
This day begin with light
winds from N.W. steering S.E.
engaged at work rigging boats etc.
35 - 13 N
122 - 50 W

Nov 27
Moderate winds in first part from
N.W. Employed at breaking out
provisions, storing rum, putting out
cutting stage, etc. Scattered part light
air from Westward
34 - 28 N
122 - 36 W

(Def. & Port
Vancouver)

on North Pacific Ocean

Nov. 28th
First part thick fog, and calms
Latter part light air from S.S.W.
No observations to-day

Nov. 29th
Light air and calms.
Saw a Humpback and several
Finbacks

Strong breeze from N.W. steering S.E. sighted a schooner
steering to the North
32. 29 N

Dec 1st
Strong breeze from N.W. with
rain squalls steering S.E.

Gaudaloupe

Stronger breeze from N.W.
