 Steering W. by S.
 Lat. 20. - 06. N.
 Long. 141. - 51. W.

Jan. 7th.
 This day begins with light wind from
 the East, Latter part, wind, stronger
 Employed on the boats, put the
 Starboard boat out, and painted
 it also painted Waist boat, and
 rolled over the Starboard boat
 repaired it and got it ready
 for painting.

Jan. 8th.
 Light wind from E. E.
 Employed on the boats, and
 finished. Steering W. by S.
 Lat. 20. - 28. N.
 Long. 145. - 58. W.

 winds, and rain, from the Southward
 Latter part calm
 Steering W. by S. No. Obs.

Jan. 10th.
 This day begins with strong wind
 from S. E. middle part, wind on
 all sides, with rain squalls,
 Saw some Finbacks to-day
 Latter part light wind from S. W.
 Steering W. by S. when possible
 Lat. 20. - 25. N.
 Long. 148. - 05. W.

Jan. 11th.
 Begins with moderate breeze from
 Westward. Latter part rain
 squalls, and wind shifting to
 the North. Steering W. by S. E. S.
 when possible
 Lat. 20. - 54. N.
 Long. 150. - 33. W.

Jan. 12th.
 Moderate Trade winds,
 Saw some Finbacks,
 Variously employed
 Steering W. by S. E. S.
 Lat. 20 - 21. N.
 Long 152 - 30 - 30 W
