miles distant,

Strong breeze from S. W.
at alter part wind moderating, vessel
working to the Southward
Employed breaking out,

Jan. 16th
Moderate wind from S. W.
Vessel working to the S. W.
Variously employed.

Jan. 17th
This day begins with light breeze
from East.
Middle part heavy rain and calm,
wind hauling to the Northward.
Vessel making around to the S. W. of
Hawaii

Cruising around Hawaii

Jan. 18th
Light winds with rain, at
daylight saw 3 vessels, Northern
Light and Starboul.

At 6 P.M. jammed the Starboul.

Jan. 19th
Light winds and calms
with heavy rain squalls.

Jan. 20th
Variable winds, and calms,
the whole 24 hours.

Jan. 21st
Calms all these 24 hours
Variously employed

Jan. 22nd
Light breeze from the Westward,
at dark 10 Whaler in sight
heading to the North,

Jan. 23rd
First part calm, latter part light
breeze from S. W. Three whalers
in sight

Jan. 24th
Light winds and calms,
4 vessels in sight. Jammed 1 Bk.
Northern Light.

Jan. 25th
First part strong breeze from
N. E. Middle part calm, spoke
the Bk. E. P. Hairman
