Feb. 11th

Moderate trade winds.

Employed setting up Main
stay, and Main rigging.

Later part steering S. E. by E.
for Hawaii, 2 vessels in sight.

Feb. 12.

Moderate trade winds

Employed in setting Shearpoles,
untent G. Top-sail, and other
ship duties. Steering to the
S. E. Hawaii bearing E. 20 miles.

Feb. 13.

Water
Cook Pork
H. H. H.
H. H. H. Molasses

Light winds from all quarters
Employed putting wooden rattlings
on Main Rigging, and breaking
out water and provisions

Cruising around Sandwich Ids.

Feb. 14th

Moderate wind from the South
& Whalers in sight. Spoke 13k.
Northern Light.

Feb. 15th

Light wind from Southward,
Loosing off Hawaii, Employed
putting wooden rattlings on Main
rigging, also painted everything aloft,
Spoke Brig Alexander,

Feb. 16th

Light breeze from the South.
Employed washing, and painting
the ship outside, 5 vessels in sight.

Feb. 17th

Moderate breeze from the South
started painting ship outside
but had to stop on account
of wind, overhauled the windlass
and painted the iron work, also
repairing M. I. Stay sail,

Feb. 18

Light winds and calms
painted a little more on Star-
board side at 8 A.M. the
boat went ashore at Karakakoa
bay and did a little trading.
Later part Rain.
