Mar. 13

Strong trade wind with a heavy swell

Mar. 14th

The same as preceding 24 hours.

Mar. 15th

Strong N.E. trade lying off and on Honolulu.

Mar. 16

Strong trade, at noon Capt Robinson went ashore, Latter part hauled up cables and bent on all ready to anchor.

Mar. 17

Strong trades at daylight kept off and run in to an anchor, outside the reef in 15 fathoms water, pumped out all the salt water, and hoisted the sperm oil on deck, also broke out some provisions.

Mar. 18

Took aboard, about 6000 Gals fresh water and some provisions and discharged out. Sperm oil.

Mar. 19

At work stowing off the Hold at 10 A.M. hove up anchor and the rest of the day lying off and on the port

Mar. 20th

Lying off and on Honolulu.

March 21, 1892

Laying off and on Honolulu received one seaman onboard 20 ends.

March 22

Brig lying off and on Honolulu received one Seaman onboard 20 ends Log ends here

March 23.

Log starts here

Brig off and on Honolulu, at three o'clock Capt Devoll came on board keep off & stowed anchor & chains, worked off deck all well. Latter part steering to the North

March 24

Hands employed at various jobs course N.W. ship on all sail latter part strong trades.

March 25.

Strong trades course N.W. by W latter part same.

March 26.

Hands employed fithing weather clothes course N.W. Brig under all sail strong trades.

March 27.

Strong trades course N.W. latter part same.

March 28.

Broke out rope cask set up topmast. top gale & royal back stays repaired main topsail course N.W.
