Thursday June 30 1892.

A. M. Hands busy washing bone, running the Brig under short sail to the East. S. East - "all well"

Friday July 1. 1892.

A. M. Hands busy washing bone.

P. M. drying & bundling. at three o'clock saw the Island of Amalaska, ahead course E. S. E.

Saturday July 2 1892.

A. M. Keck off at day light - run to the Eastward until eight am. how to off shore light winds & calms.

A. M. Light winds & Calms

P. M. light wind from South steering toward the land.

Monday July 4 1892.

A. M. eight o'clock dropped anchor at Amalaska. P. M. lowered the boats and towed the Brig into duck harbor.

Hands busy getting ready for water. breaking out the hole & pumping out water at dark finished

Wednesday July 6 1892

At Anchor. Hands busy at several jobs.

Hauled Brig to the dock took on coal and some water.

Hands at - ships duty

P. M. taking in water

A. M. finished coal & water - P. M. hauled ship into the stream & anchored.

Tuesday July 12 1892

Hands busy painting ship. Took Wm. Keck ashore and discharged him sent him home in San Francisco.

Wednesday July 13. 1892

A. M. lower out - clear of sand spit and anchored. at ten o'clock took on anchor and stood to sea. S. schooner Bohemian had eight boxes of potatoes course N. W. spoke the Mohican

Thursday July 14 1892.

Hands busy at ship duty came N. W. by N. strong breeze
