Friday July 15 1892.

Hands at ships duty - fimbriata in sight
course N.W. strong breeze from the
westward. fog & rain - one ship in sight

Water.

Saturday July 16, 1892

Hands at Ships duty - fog & rain
working to the N.W.

Sunday July 18 1892.

Good breeze from S.W. course West-
cought one lost fish fog & calm.
all.

Monday July 18 1892.

Hands at various jobs. ripped the fly
jib over made weather cloth & laid out the
beautiful weather.

Tuesday July 19 1892.

Fine weather Hands at ships duty -
light wind S.W. course west. all well.

Lat 57-45. Long 168-46.

Wednesday July 20, 1892.

At day light sighted the Bk Josephine -
P.M. at half past three gained her.
reports having struck and lost one whale
near leaving Annalaska.

Thursday July 21, 1892.

Hands at ships duty fog & rain - wind at
West - south west - one ship in sight -
fin back.

Lat 57-45. Long 170-06.

Friday July 22 1892.

Steering to the westward all well.
Hands at ships duty.

Saturday 23, 1892.

Hands at ships duty. Running to
the southward. St. Paul Island in sight -
latter part steering S.E. by S. in mist
fog.

Sunday 24 1892.

Hands at ships duty. passed the cutter
Corwin at one o'clock. blowing stiff from
the W.S.W. minus fog & rain

Monday 25-1892.

A.M. Run on the Northern track.
at seven o'clock Kept off east - at
dark hove to on the Southern track aback
towed for fish with out success from backs
Killis's pupping figs & seals

Tuesday July 26 1892.

Kept off to the north at daylight - wind
S.E. rain & fog. P.M. steering N.W.E.
