

Remarks on board Brig "H. Bonaventure."

Thursday Aug 18th

Commenced with fresh breeze from the South at 4 o'clock A.M. Kept off N.W. under all sail until 10 AM, then hauled up E.N.E. at 4 P.M. raised the Land, stood in to Bay Cape and kept off N.W. to clear Blinn's Shoals at 9 P.M. shifted sail and headed inshore until 3 A.M. so ends this day.

Friday Aug 19th

Light breeze from the S.W. stood into the Land south of Wampanoag Point and kept off along the Land to the North. Followed the Land all day, at 7 o'clock P.M. came to anchor off Refuge, but little calm so ends this day.

Saturday Aug 20th

Commenced with light S.W. breeze and at 6 A.M. got underway and stood to the N. Wards Cape Smith. Sent a Boat on board the Bonaventure off Cape Smith at 5 P.M. Came to anchor off Point Bonaventure at 5 P.M. The Mate Mr. Robinson was taken suddenly sick and at 10 to 11 P.M. died and in the night he died. He died before he arrived. Had an autopsy but failed to find the cause of his death. Suffered to be April 1890. so ends this day.

Sunday Aug 21st

Commenced with light breeze from the N.W. Finer sun's side. Afternoon Bonaventure the Mate on the Land. Several ladies attended by the ship's crew. Lying here at anchor. Afternoon and N.E. and fresh breeze so ends this day.

Monday Aug. 22nd

Commenced with strong N.E. breeze still lying at anchor under the Point. sun's side. Afternoon still lying fresh from the N.E.

Tuesday Aug 23rd

Commenced with light wind from N.W. at 6 A.M. took the anchor and stood off shore at 9 A.M. Anchored N.E. of the point. Scatter part. wind from N.E. took the anchor and went back around the point again.

Wed. Aug. 24th

Strong breeze from the Eastward with thick weather

Thur. Aug. 25th

At 11th Molasses Fresh breeze from Eastward, still lying at anchor, took Potatoes from Storehold and put them down in the Kurr.

Fri Aug 26th

Bread Light breeze from the East
Beans At 9 A.M. got under way, and at
Rice 11 A.M. anchored at Cape Smith.
Coke Employed breaking out Provisions
